Hi Everett,

The current COVID regulations in place from the state do not require athletes who are participating to wear face coverings. There are concerns of wearing a mask during physical exertion. There also isn't a MHSAA requirement to wear face coverings during play except for coaches and substitutes on the bench.

With that said the other team(s) do not have to wear face coverings. A visiting team could wear masks but they do not have to during play. Your school could play games on the road if the visiting team does not want to wear masks during play or if not, the game would be considered a no-contest.
