Minutes of the October 22, 2007 Regular School Board Meeting

The Board of Trustees of the Coppell Independent School District, #057-922, met in a regular session on October 22, 2007 at 6:31 p.m. in the Board Room of the Vonita White Administration Administration Building, 200 S. Denton Tap Road, Coppell. The meeting was called to order by President Kathie Gautille.

At 6:31 p.m. President Gautille declared the Board in closed session, as authorized under the Government Code of Texas, as allowed by Section 551.074 (Personnel Matters).

At 6:34 p.m. President Gautille declared the Board in Open Session.

PUBLIC HEARING

Opportunity was given for the public to provide input to the Board of Trustees regarding grants being submitted to the CEDC for approval. No one came forward to address the Board of Trustees.

A public hearing was held regarding HB621 (taxation of tangible personal property held temporarily at a location in this state for assembling, storing, manufacturing, processing, or fabricating purposes).

CONSENT

Item 5 (Approval of Knowsys Test Prep LLC) was removed from the Consent Agenda for separate consideration.

Cindy Warner made a motion to approve the following consent agenda items:

Scott Orr seconded the motion. The motion carried 7-0.

After discussion concerning the bid process, David Apple made a motion to approve Knowsys Test Prep LLC as the awarded vendor for the Coppell ISD SAT Test Prep Proposal #0701 (Item 5 on the Consent Agenda). Susie Kemp seconded the motion. The motion carried 7-0.

ACTION

Bennett Ratliff made a motion to approve the following grants, as presented, to the Coppell Education Development Corporation: Coppell Spanish Program, $Pre-K - 12^{th}$ Grade English as a Second Language, and the Literacy Intervention Support Program. Anthony Hill seconded the motion. The motion carried 7-0.

Cindy Warner made a motion to move forward with a Letter of Intent to the New Technology Foundation to replicate their learning model at the CISD academy high school. Scott Orr seconded the motion. The motion carried 7-0.

Bennett Ratliff made a motion to adopt a resolution as presented allowing the Coppell Independent School District to tax goods-in-transit which are otherwise exempt under Section 11.253(b) of the Texas Property Tax Code and otherwise not exempt under other law. David Apple seconded the motion. The motion carried 7-0.

Cindy Warner made a motion that the Board add, revise, or delete (LOCAL) policies as recommended by TASB Policy Service and according to the Instruction Sheet for TASB Localized Policy Manual Update 81 (see attachment), as well as additional changes recommended by staff to EIF (LOCAL): Academic Achievement – Graduation, and FMG (LOCAL): Student Activities – Travel. Anthony Hill seconded the motion. The motion carried 7-0.

David Apple made a motion to accept resignations for CISD professional personnel as per list presented. Susie Kemp seconded the motion. The motion carried 7-0.
