Dear Superintendent:

I am currently a Texas DPS Certified School Safety Instructor for the Guardian Program as required under House Bill 3. I am also an LTC instructor in the Lubbock/Plainview area, NRA Pistol Instructor, and a Range Safety Officer.

The School Guardian Program (as required under House Bill 3) certifies teachers and or employees to carry firearms on campuses, at school districts allowing Guardians to carry firearms. The training curriculum utilized was developed by the Department of Public Safety (required 16 hours) and conducted as required. We are flexible in our scheduling, allows for training to be conducted during the week and weekends as needed (training days do not have to be consecutive).

At the time of this letter this year we have trained the following ISD's: Floydada, Springlake Earth, Ascension Academy (Amarillo), Crowell, Rise Academy (Lubbock), Betty Condra, White Deer, Ralls, Meadow, Morton, Seminole, Moran, Munday, Sanderson, Amherst, Kress, Groom, Lockney, Crosbyton. Some schools we have returned to and conducted annual training as well. In the process of training more throughout the remainder of the year.

About me:

I am a retired Army disabled combat veteran, served in the infantry during combat operations. I have about 35 years of experience with shooting. My desire is to train for safety and proficiency, not to be soldiers.

I am an NRA Certified Instructor (Instructor #225211945), Texas License to Carry (LTC) Instructor (Instructor #06398861), Certified School Safety Course Instructor (Instructor #06398861), and NRA Range Safety Officer (Instructor #225211945). In the remote chance there would be medical attention required, I have extensive first-aid training from his military service and have fully stocked M-17 medical kit during live fire training. These medical supplies are capable of dressing bullets wounds.

Required Course Content:

This is a Texas Department of Public Safety Certification course designed to train and evaluate educators to carry defensive handguns on school campuses. We provide the Texas D.P.S. approved training for school districts, teachers, and staff. During the state-mandated two days of instruction we place students into real-world scenarios and testing. The four core topics instructed as required by the Texas Department of Public Safety (TXDPS)

- Protection of Students
- Interaction of license holders with first responders
- Tactics for denying an intruder entry into a classroom or school facility
- Methods for increasing a license holder's accuracy with a handgun while under duress

Upon successful completion of the course, the participant will receive a Texas D.P.S. Proof of Training Form. Completed courses will then be filed with the Texas Department of Public Safety as a part of their License to Carry in accordance with Texas Government Code 411.1901.

Teachers or employees must first have taken the LTC class prior to taking the School Safety Course.

Our fee for an LTC per person-\$60

Guardian Program per person fee is (qualifies those who successfully complete the course to carry a firearm)- \$250

Guardian Program Without the Firearm Portion (minimum 50 student)- \$10 per attendee

(Guardian without the firearm teaches all the aspects of the Guardian Program except for the firearms sections, taught in an 8-hour class. Does not certify employees to carry a firearm. Topics covered are avoiding the threat, denying entry to the building and classroom, defending the classroom).
