The Academic Letter Winners Assembly will be held on November 13th. Mr. Musselman was our guest speaker. Congratulations to the 38 current students that were recognized that day. In addition, we recognized 12 students from the class of 2018 last spring. We had a total of 49 students (25.5%) who achieved a 3.670 GPA during the 2018-2019 School Year.
