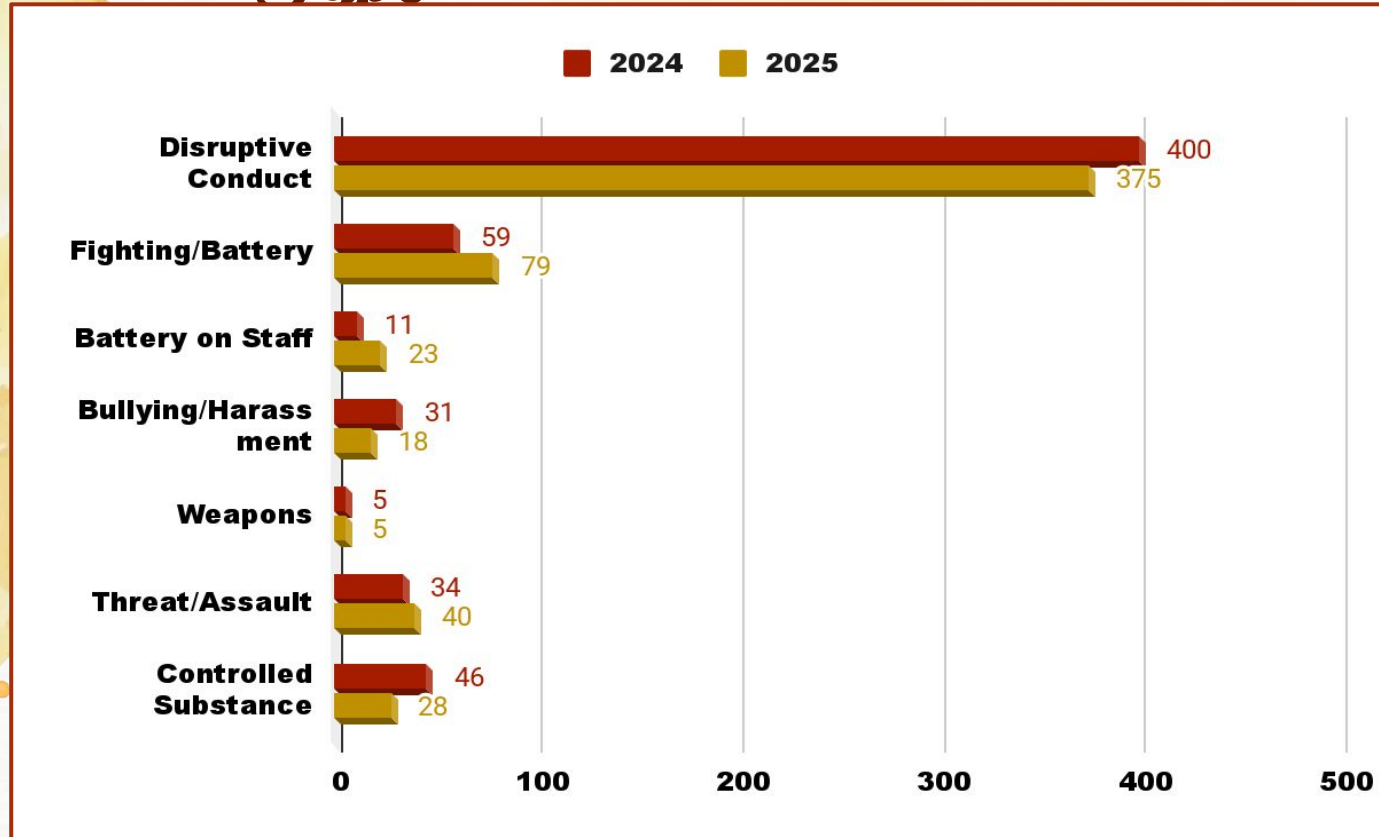




Behavior Incidents by Location
