RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of six years of digital access and classroom textbooks: *Social Studies Alive! America's Past* for fifth grade and *Geography Alive! Regions and People* for sixth grade, from TCI, for a total cost of \$230,233.50.

RATIONALE:

The textbook was evaluated using the district textbook adoption process. Upper elementary school principals and the Curriculum Committee support the recommendation.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

The funding for this purchase will come from the Academic Services Department Secondary Textbook Fund, which is supported by the Wayne County Enhancement Millage. This purchase includes \$51,525.00 in free materials, including the print Teacher Guides, six years of teacher digital licenses, and activity cards.
