## CURRICULUM

Browning Public Schools Early Kindergarten (EK) - 12th grade is now in the second year of new program implementation within the CORE programs of ELA, mathematics, science, and social studies. In June, the building SBE committees prioritized work to refine instructional frameworks, implementation plans, and make consumable materials purchases for the 23-24 SY. Each school's SBE team, composed of grade-level teachers, contributed to the planning work with teacher representation of 8-12 core content staff per building. The SBE planning week was an enormous success giving teachers confidence and a voice in decision making. Building principals and instructional coaches participated in and facilitated the work. Again, this year, we used ESSER Instructional Learning Loss funds to support extended contracts and curricula purchases.

## INSTRUCTION

### District Leadership Week

The District Leadership Team (DLT), composed of principals, assistant principals, instructional coaches, teachers, and district admin met the week of July 31-August 4 for our first DLT meeting and building level SLT planning. The week's agenda included; the 22-23 District EOY Data Share, building level action plan priorities and alignment to the BPS Strategic Plan for the 23-24 SY, extended Wednesday PD Calendar Planning, and finalizing beginning of year planning. In addition, each building began working on their building level literacy plan and the Profile of a BPS Graduate/Learner.

*What are Benchmark Screening, Diagnostic Assessment, Progress-monitoring, & Outcome Measures?*

September is a critical month for determining a student’s instructional needs. BPS measures students' needs with benchmark screening, diagnostic assessment, and begins progress-monitoring. All in preparation for annual outcome measures. But, what specifically are these tools and how do educators use them to support high-quality instruction for ALL students?

**Benchmark Screening** - at BPS, benchmark or universal screening is conducted 3 x’s/year for ELA and mathematics and two times/ year for social-emotional learning. The purpose of benchmark screening is to identify students “at risk” who may need intervention/ support, as well as identify those students who are working at-grade level in comparison to their same-aged peers. This is a formative measure used to identify students in need.

**Diagnostic Assessment** - Diagnostic assessment is given to a student within a content area such as ELA and/ or mathematics to identify those specific skills that need to be supported in a student's instructional plan. Diagnostic assessment is conducted in September of each year at BPS and throughout the year, as needed for both general education and special education students. This is a formative measure used to drive instruction.

**Progress-monitoring** - Progress-monitoring is administered to students on a regular basis (weekly, 10-day cycles, or monthly) within a specific skill area/ task to determine if the student is making growth in regard to his/ her current instructional program regarding that specific skill. This is a formative measure used to determine if a change needs to be made with a student's instructional plan.

**Annual Outcome Measures** - Annual outcome measures are state-level assessments such as Smarter Balance, ACCESS 2.0 for EL's, CRT-Science, the ACT with Writing, as well as alternate forms of these assessments for some students. These assessments measure a student's annual growth in comparison to the expected skill of his/ her same-aged peers. BPS participates in all of the assessments above as a part of the state-wide assessment plan from the Office of Public Instruction.

### **aimswEBPLUS**



The aimswEBPLUS benchmark screening window is August 21 - September 29, 2023. Students K-10 will take the fall screening measures in both ELA & mathematics. Building and district-level data will be compiled and reported to the school board, provided to the Office of Public Instruction as part of the requirements of the MCLSDP and Title I Continuous School Improvement, and School Leadership Teams will design targeted interventions to support students needing additional instruction.

### **English Language Learner Screening**



BPS is identifying English Language Learners across the district. This is a multi-step process that begins with the Home Language Survey provided to the family upon initial enrollment in the district. Based upon the survey, follow-up steps may include administering the WIDA MODEL (K) or WIDA online screening (1-12). Newly identified EL students must be reported to OPI through the Infinite Campus System to ensure assessment materials are assigned to the student for the annual ACCESS for ELLs statewide assessment. KVV will be screening kindergarten students during the month of September for potential EL program participation.
