In accordance with Texas law, (TEA) Purchasing code Section 44.031 Subchapter B; Coppell ISD's Purchasing and Child Nutrition Departments recently released four Request for Proposals (RFPs) to qualified vendors for the (4) four major Child Nutrition categories listed above. All bids were sent out as part of the Prospering Pals Purchasing Cooperative. Prospering Pals is a purchasing cooperative hosted and managed by Coppell ISD and includes twenty seven (27) school districts in our area. This cooperative was formed several years ago in order to increase the purchasing power of Coppell ISD and all other respective school districts who are a part of the Prospering Pals Cooperative.

Also, in compliance with Texas purchasing law, Pride Performance Consulting LLC released, under CISD's Prospering Pals Commodity Processing Cooperative another RFP in search of vendors to provide the various commodities needed for our Child Nutrition Department. RFP # TX170120CPC was released to the public on November 28, 2016 and was an extension of the previously Board approved RFP, #TX150126CPC. In addition to the release, copies of the new RFP were also sent to qualified current, and prospective bidders. Based on the results of all the proposals received, Pride Performance Consulting recommended the award of RFP # TX170120CPC to all the vendors listed in the attached letter below.
