RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of CogAT and Iowa Testing Materials from Riverside Insights for a cost of \$31,492.76 for testing sixth and eighth graders and identifying students for our Academically Talented programs. This purchase includes online testing licenses for both tests and training on how to administer the tests online.

RATIONALE:

The CogAT testing materials will provide our sixth and eighth grade students a nationally normed assessment experience and will provide information for teachers on their students' abilities, and content area strengths and weaknesses. The Iowa test is utilized as part of our identification process for our Academically Talented programs.
