- Our Winter Activities start to look towards the Postseason as all are past the halfway point of their seasons.

Athletics Updates**Dance**

- The Rangerettes prepare for their Postseason with the Heart O'Lakes Conference Championship next Tuesday 1/27 in Hawley. They have won both the Jazz and Kick HOL Conference Meets and are looking to defend their overall Championship for the third consecutive year. Next week is the Section Championships once again in Hawley on 1/31 where they will be looking to defend their titles and make the State Championships in both Jazz and Kick.

Hockey

- The Girls Northern Lakes team are currently 8-10-2 on the season. They have four scheduled games left this season before starting their Postseason in early February. The Boys Northern Lakes team is 10-6-1 overall and currently #14 in Class A by Let's Play Hockey. They have their next 6 games at Home including 1/24, 1/31 & 2/4 at the Hallett Center.

Boys Basketball

- The Ranger Boys are 7-8 at this point in their season and have a 4-3 record in the Great River Conference. They are currently on a four game winning streak and will look to continue that streak next week as they host Pillager on 1/27. With many Section opponents upcoming they will look to position themselves to host a 1st Round Home Playoff game.

Girls Basketball

- The Lady Rangers are 13-5 on the season, they are currently ranked #2 in Class AA and #17 by the Minnesota Star Tribune in their last all schools ranking. They have won 6 of their last 7 games and look to stay undefeated in Great River Conference play. This past Tuesday, Tori Oehrlein became the Minnesota Girls All-Time Scoring Leader eclipsing the mark of 5060 points that was held by Rebekah Dahlman. Dahlman was on hand in the Galovich Gym to help honor Tori on becoming the All-Time leader.

Wrestling

- The Wrestlers have a week before their Postseason begins in Ogilvie at the Great River Conference Championships. Overall in team competitions they are 3-6 on the season in dual competitions with three more dual/tri/quad matches upcoming. Deacon Larson leads the Ranger Boys with 23 victories so far on the season, followed by Ezra Jacobson and Parker Cash who both have 18. On the Girls side Naomi Ridlon leads with 13 victories, Madellyn Monier has 9 and Grayce Matich with 8.
