**ITEM: VII.E.**

**TOPIC:      Approval of Additional Seats for Limited Schools of Choice**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools District accept the recommendation of the superintendent to open a total of 50 additional seats under Section 105c, which allows for enrollment of out of district students under Limited Schools of Choice, for the 2015-16 school year. The breakdown for enrollment would be: Kindergarten (25 seats), 1<sup>st</sup> grade (10 seats), 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grades (5 seats each = 15 seats) for a total of 50 additional seats. The registration window would be May 19 – June 2, 2015.

**RATIONALE:**

Section 105c Limited Schools of Choice will bring additional revenue to the district and preserve programs essential to the students of Livonia Public Schools.

**BUDGETARY INFORMATION:**

This recommendation is being made for the purpose of added revenue to the general fund, up to \$400,000.
