Conducted every three years

Report results to district's board of trustees

Vulnerability Self-Assessment Tool (VSAT)

Multi-hazard Emergency Operations Plan

Address mitigation, preparedness, response
and recovery

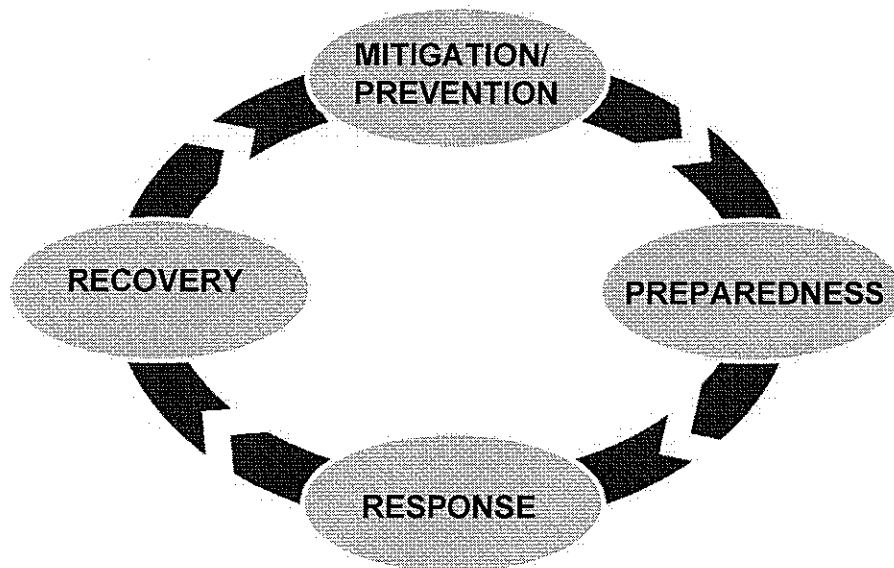
Provide for:

- District employee training
- Mandatory school drills
- Measures to ensure coordination with local
emergency management agencies
- Implementation of a security audit

Adopted by Districts no later than March 1,
2006

Emergency Management Cycle

Four phases of Emergency Management



Mitigation/Prevention

Goals:

- Eliminate or reduce hazards and security risks

Includes:

- Hazard Analysis and Security Audits
- Programs:
 - Anti-bullying
 - Violence reduction
- Code of Conduct and Dress Code



Preparedness

Goals:

- Staff and students effectively respond to an emergency

Includes:

- Multi-hazard Emergency Operations Plan
- Training
- Drills

Response

Goals:

- Minimize loss of life and property
- Terminate the incident

Includes:

- Steps taken during an emergency
- Time when the EOP is put into action
