RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a significant portion of the District's ad valorem taxes are delinquent to the District's detriment; and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas pursuant to the Texas Property Tax Code, provides school districts with the authority to impose a 16% collection fee and/or charge on delinquent ad valorem taxes of the current 2012 tax year, when it has entered into a tax collection contract with an attorney; and

WHEREAS, the District has engaged a private law firm to collect its delinquent ad valorem taxes, and the contract provides for a 16% collection fee and/or charge.

IT IS THEREFORE, HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE UNITED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

- 1. That the District does hereby exercise its right to impose an additional 16% collection fee and/or charge on all delinquent taxes, penalties and interest due, pursuant to the terms of the Tax Code, so long as the District retains a delinquent tax attorney, and
- 2. That the District's Tax Collector is hereby directed to send out all required notices to delinquent taxpayers of the herein imposed additional 16% collection fee and/or charge on delinquent taxes, penalty and interest, as required by the Tax Code.
