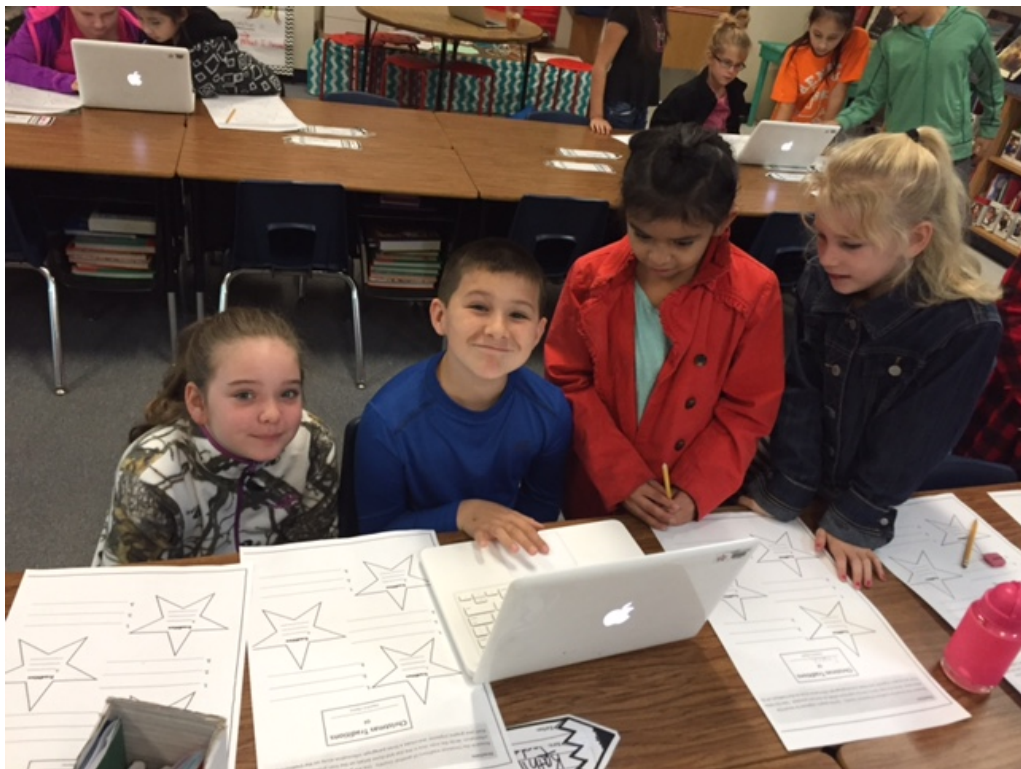
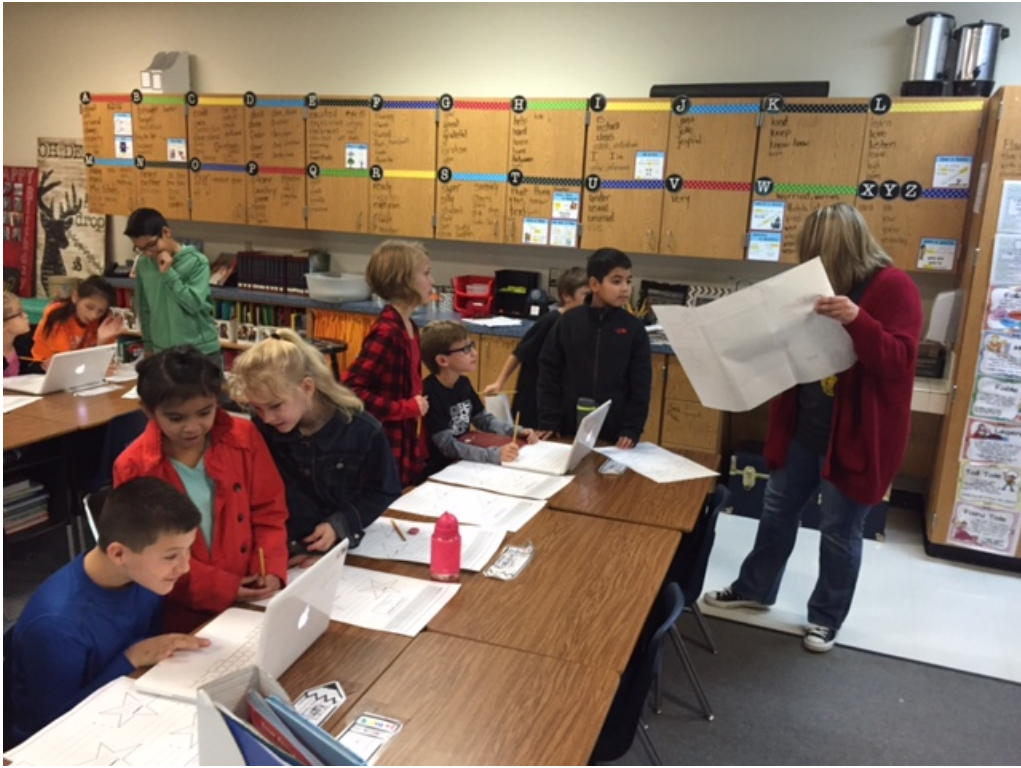

IN THE CLASSROOM:

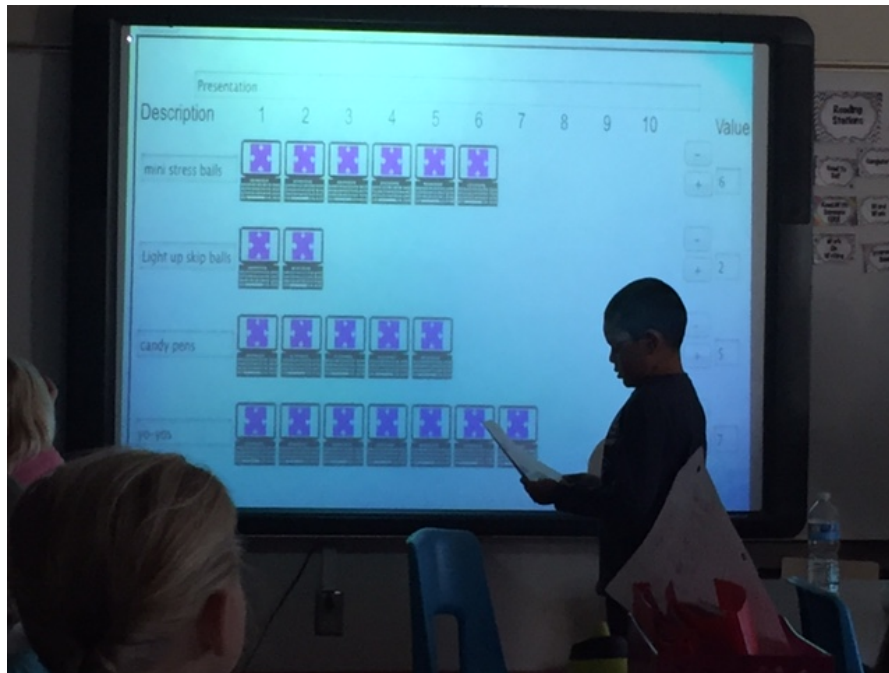
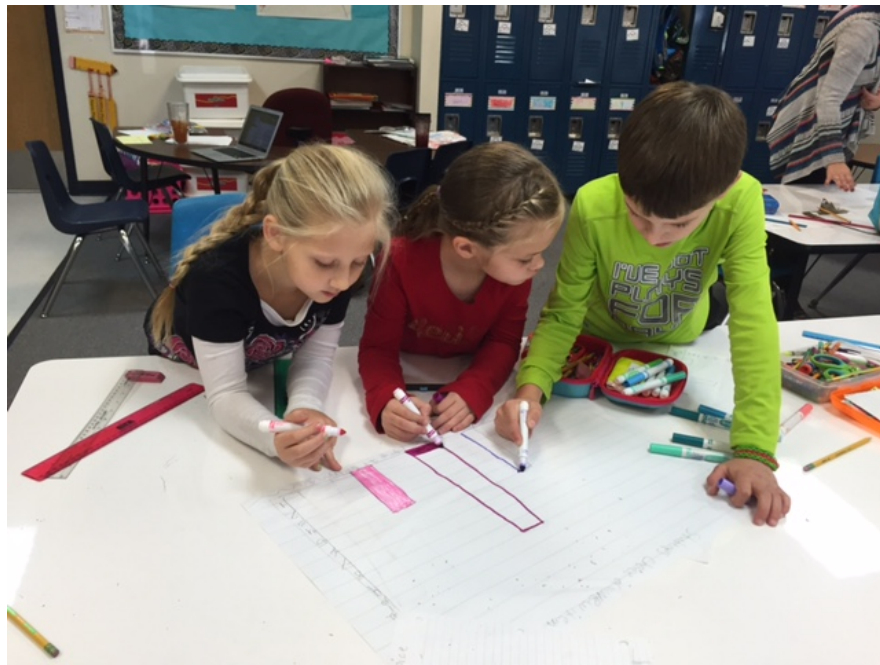

4. Mrs. Day's Music Class learns to how the play the bells in sync with each other while viewing visual music and notes of Christmas music.

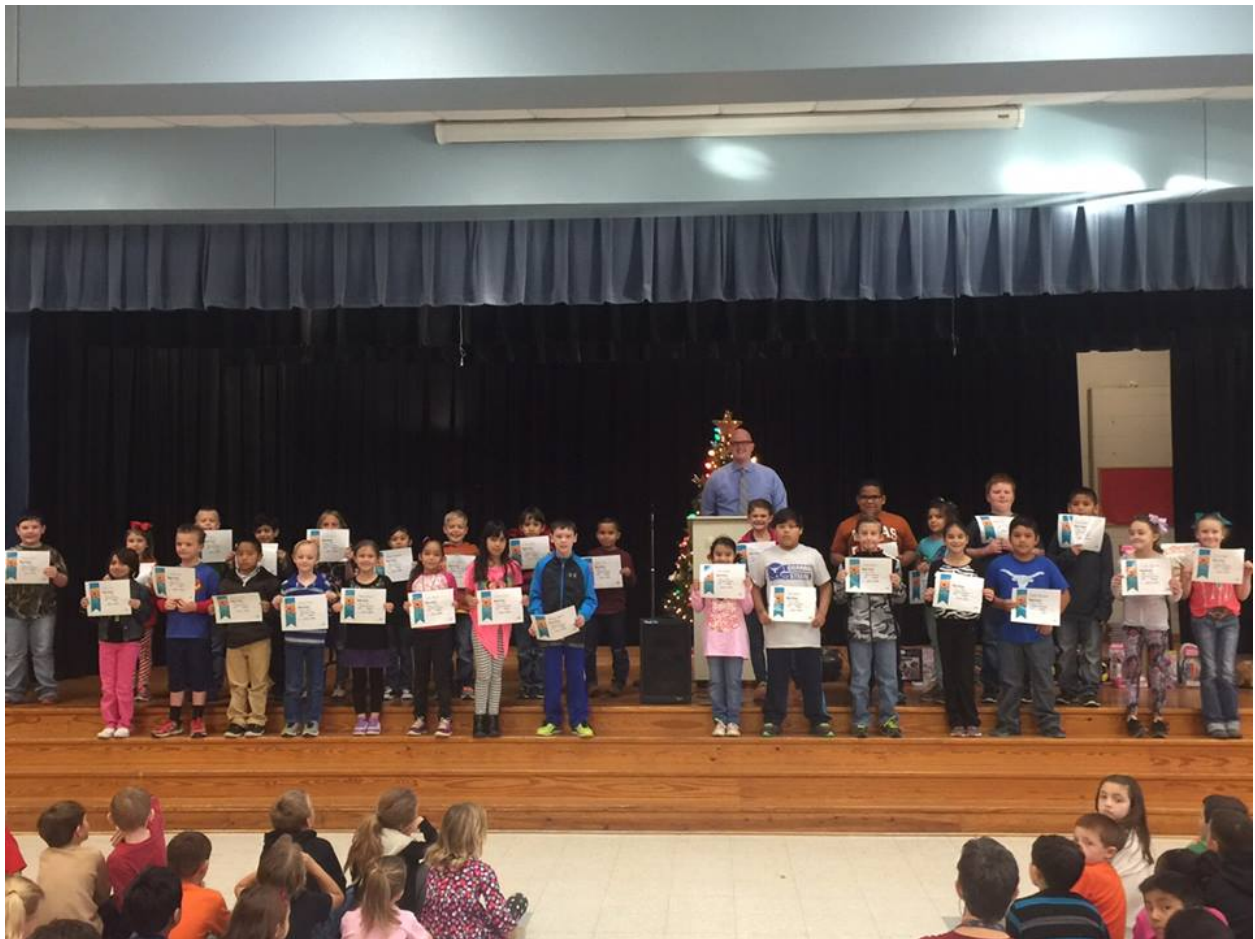


CAMPUS NEWS

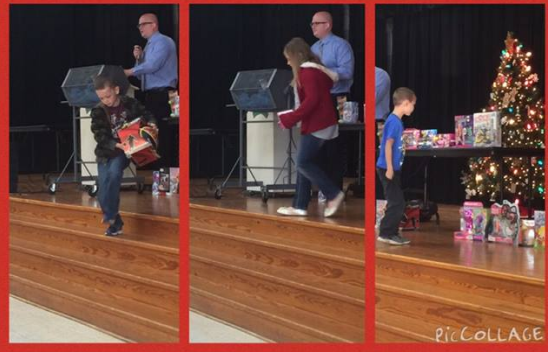
EVENTS
