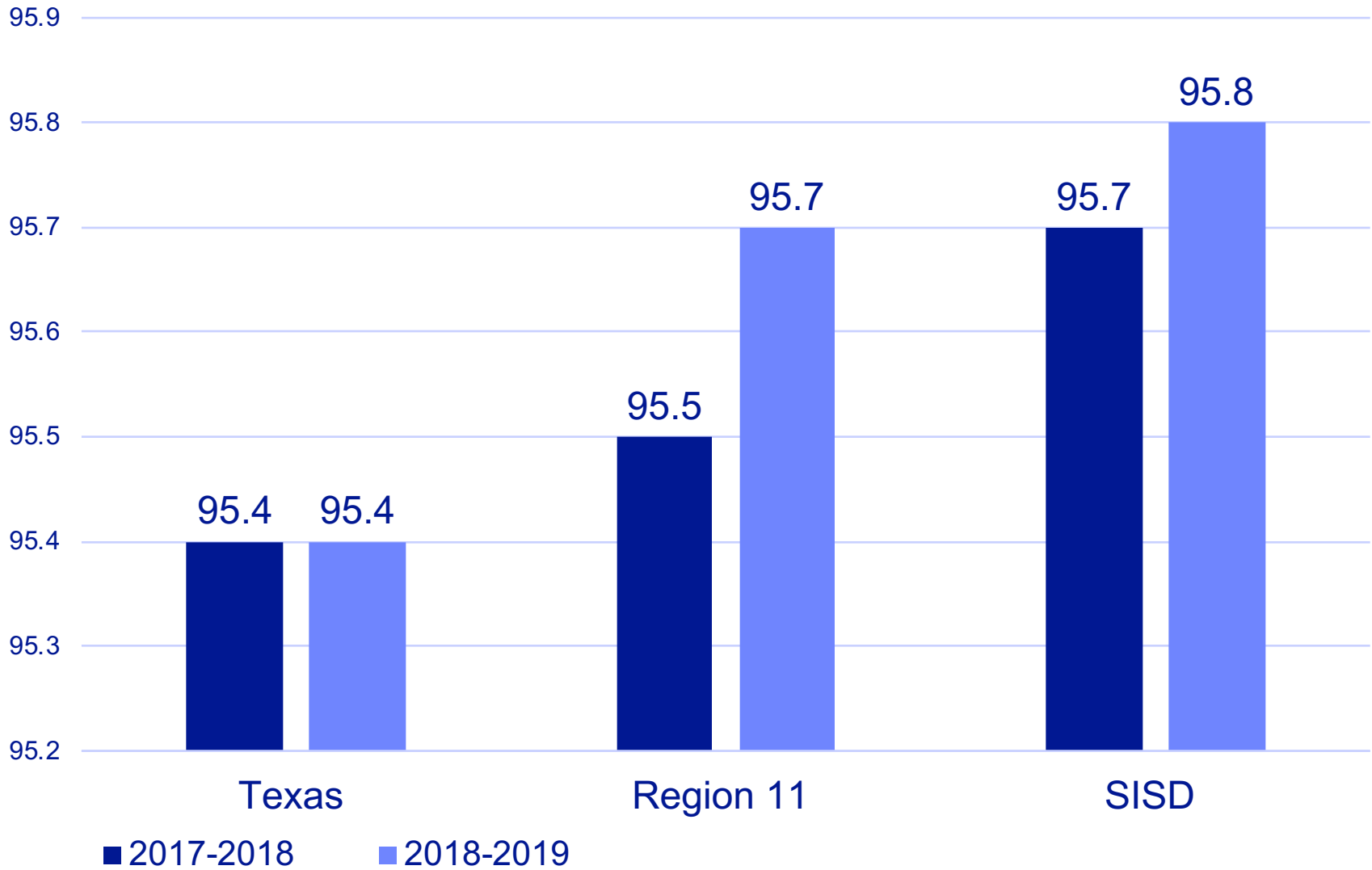

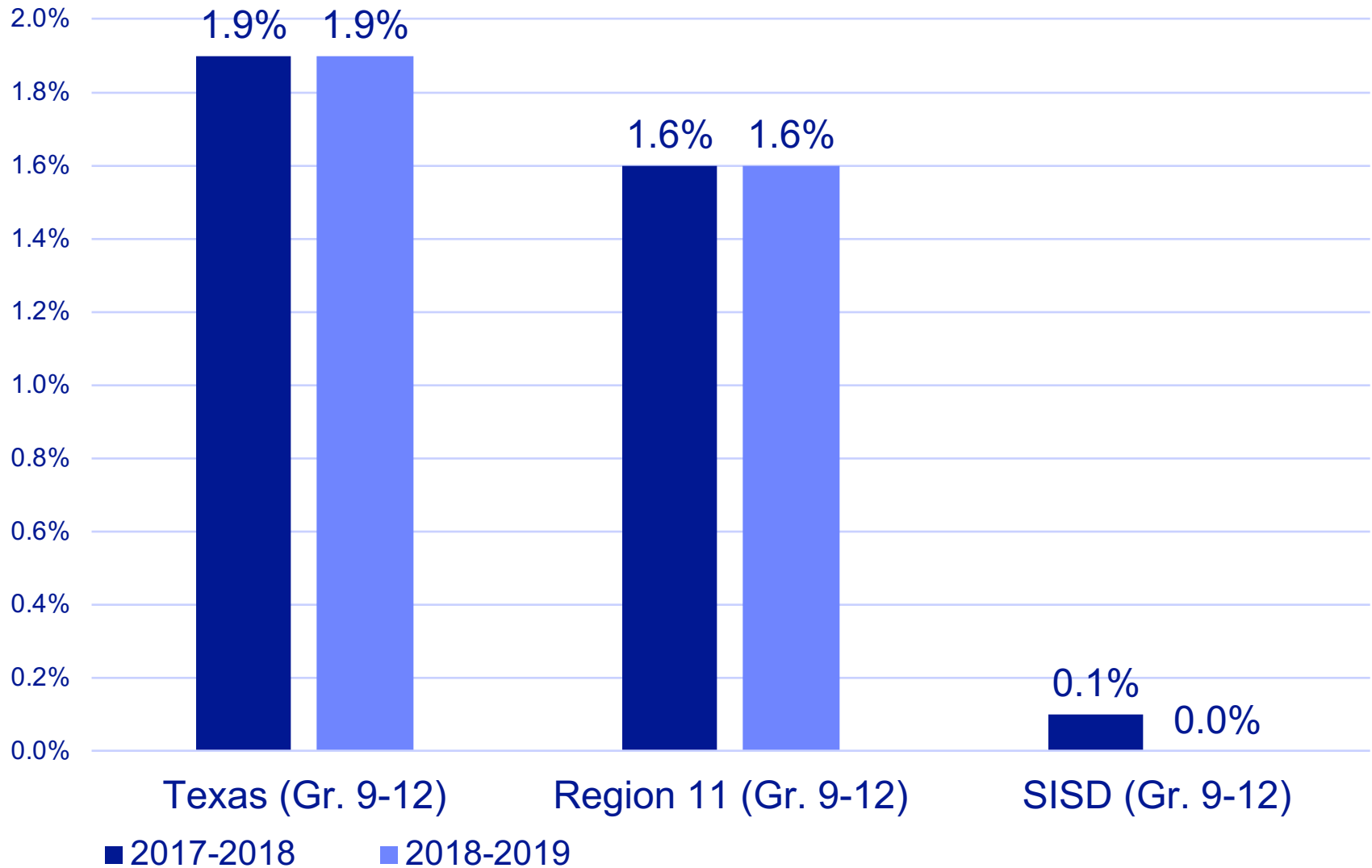


Attendance Rates



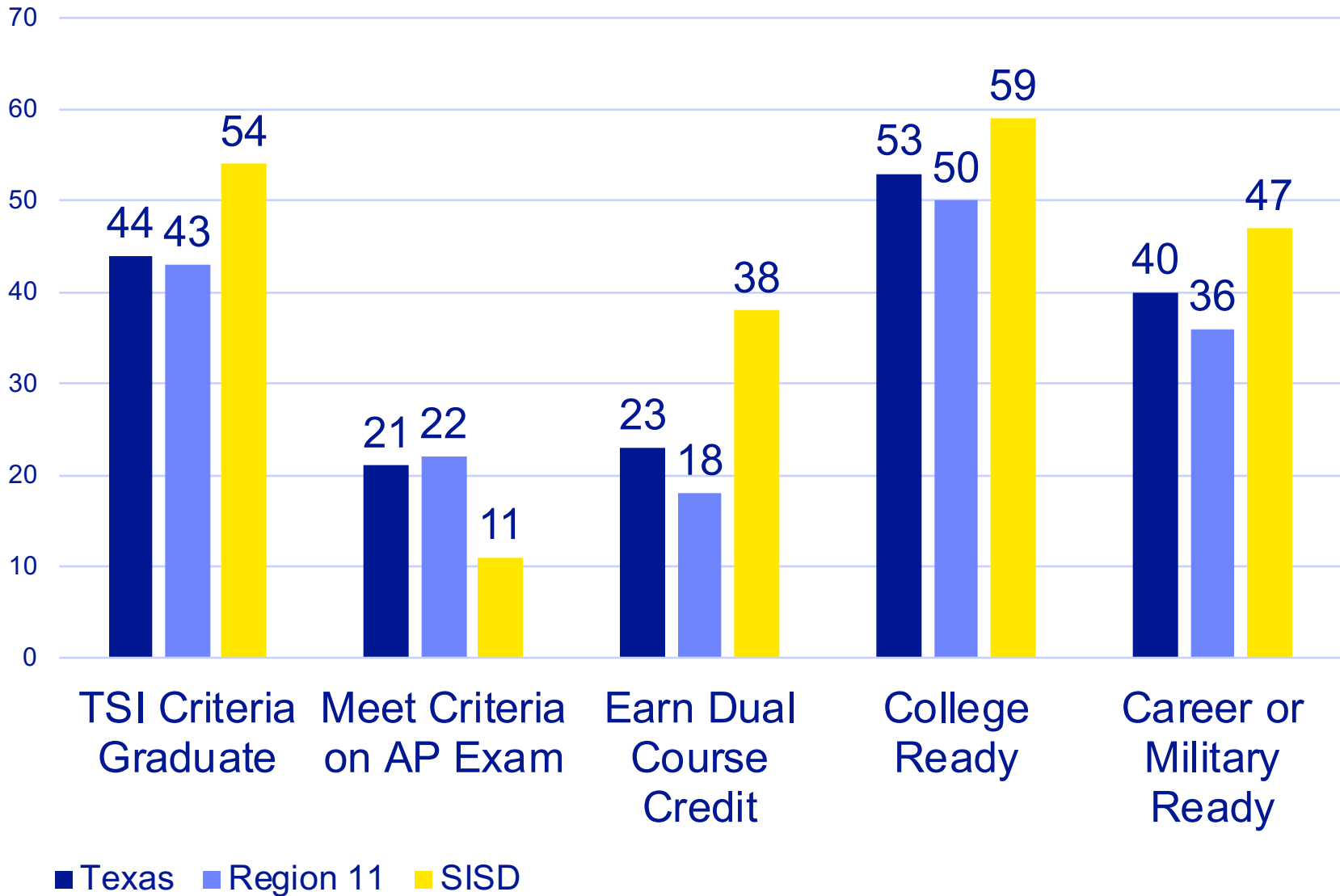


Dropout Rates
