Club Goals:

AVID Club is to help prepare all students for college or trade school readiness and success in a global society, by incorporating various AVID techniques and methods for ALL students in the middle school who are willing to accept an academic challenge. WICOR strategies and skills are promoted to all students; writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization, and reading. Students will also have the opportunity to learn & refine customer service skills through various fundraising activities. ALL BMS students will be encouraged to seek academic assistance as needed to maintain a 3.0 GPA and above in their core classes through tutoring during lunch or after school depending on student needs. AVID Club will also be used during lunchtime to provide a "safe room" to help students build positive coping skills and trust among their peers and teachers.

Proposed Meeting Time:

Various dates throughout the school year are determined by student and club needs and are anticipated to meet a minimum of twice monthly. Meeting times will be dependent on students' needs due to after-school and/or lunch tutoring being offered, in addition to the "safe room" opportunity.

Summary of Proposed Club Activities:

After school and/or lunch tutoring will be available to anticipate student needs for assistance in core classes. Opportunity to attend "safe room" during lunch when offered to students. Fundraising, career awareness opportunities, and additional campus visit opportunities by either adding additional visits or supplementing existing funding sources (i.e. GearUp) to further enhance existing visit opportunities.

Club Goals:

The Leathercraft club will provide students with the opportunity to work in a collaborative atmosphere with others who share an interest in a creative activity. Step-by-step instruction in the use of leather crafting tools, preparing leather for tooling, stamping and/or carving on leather, and dyeing/staining and finishing leather will be provided.

Proposed Meeting Time:

Various dates throughout the school year are determined by student and club needs. Anticipated to meet a minimum of twice monthly, Meeting times will be during shared lunchtime or after school to accommodate student needs periodically throughout the school year.

Summary of Proposed Club Activities:

Students learn how to make crafts that can be given as gifts or kept for personal use. Students will be asked to donate \$20 for club dues, but it will not be mandatory, as fundraising will be conducted to buy various tools and supplies as needed.
