TOPIC: Approval of Bid Results for

Demolition of Nankin Mills and Washington

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education, based upon the recommendation of the Director of Business Services Lisa Abbey, authorize the District Engineer James McMuldroch to prepare the contracts for Livonia Public Schools School District with Ahern Contracting, Inc. of Chesterfield, Michigan, to demolish Nankin Mills School for a cost of \$186,432.00; and with International Construction, Inc. of Shelby Township, Michigan, to demolish Washington School for a cost of \$179,900.00, for a total cost of \$366,332.00. Also move that upon receipt of the contracts, approved payment and performance bonds, Lisa Abbey is authorized to sign said contracts on behalf of Livonia Public Schools' Board of Education.

RATIONALE:

The condition of Nankin Mills and Washington Schools is cost prohibitive to repair and the school district is no longer in need of these two buildings.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

The source of funds for these purchases will be the Sinking Fund.
