SUBJECT:	Class-Size Exceptions for Freeport Elementary School
BOARD POLICY:	EEB (Local)
DISTRICT GOAL:	BISD learning environments will be safe and conducive to learning.
FISCAL NOTE:	None

Background Information:

- In accordance with the District's Local Innovation Plan, the District is exempt from state law requiring a district not to enroll more than 22 students in PreK-grade 4 classrooms.
- As stated in the plan, the District shall not enroll more than 24 students in kindergarten-grade 4 classrooms.
- Should a class size exceed 22:1 for more than 35 days, the Board of Trustees must approve an exception.
- Freeport Elementary has one 1st Grade Bilingual classroom that exceeds the 22:1 ratio.

Administrative Considerations:

- The district seeks to maintain a 22:1 student-to-teacher ratio in grades K-4.
- As the year progresses, at times the student-to-teacher ratio will exceed 22:1 due to new enrollment. However, the second classroom fluctuates from 22 to 23 enrolled students.
- Options to address classrooms that exceed the 22:1 maximum class size for more than 35 days include:
 - Adding a teacher
 - Add a certified teacher to the class to create a Co-Teach environment
 - Move a student enrolled by transfer back to his or her home campus or another campus in the district
 - Add a paraprofessional in accordance with district staffing ratios (This option requires the Board of Trustees to grant a class size exception.)
- Currently, Freeport Elementary School has a paraprofessional supporting the first-grade classroom. Therefore, the staff needed to adequately provide support to the classrooms for which the administration is seeking the Class-Size Exception is already in place.

- It is the administration's recommendation that the Board of Trustees approve a Class-Size Exception for the Freeport Elementary School first-grade bilingual classroom, where enrollment exceeds 22:1.
