

Superintendent Board Report

January 2026

- Dupo School District hosted the Chamber of Commerce meeting on January 15th at 11:15 in the BV library. The Bluffview cafeteria cooked chili, cookies, and apple crisp for the guests. I shared the Year in Review video, the security upgrades we have implemented this year, and the plan for the second semester.
- The Teacher Institute was held on January 5, 2026. The keynote speaker was Lori Hopkins on the Power of Your Presence. Horace Mann also provided training on TRS Tier 1 and Tier 2, as well as IMRF, for our staff. Then, the staff worked on the required mandated trainings for our annual compliance.
- Second-semester report cards were available on Friday, January 9, 2026, via Teacherease. K-1 student report cards were sent home on Monday, January 12, 2026.
- We completed the Civil Rights Review process by adding the new Nondiscrimination Statement with the two added words. We have placed it in the handbooks and on the website. The District received the final approval of our submissions. We have completed this year-long process.
- Bluffview and the Dupo Jr. High will have after-school tutoring Tuesdays and Thursdays from February 3- March 10, excluding PT Conference days.
- D.A.R.E. will start at BV on January 23rd, and the D.A.R.E. Graduation is scheduled for March 6, 2026.
