Bylaws of the Board

Standing Committees

The following shall be the standing committees of the Woodbridge Board of Education. The Chairperson shall appoint at least three Board members to each committee and may revise committee appointments at any time. The Chairperson shall be an ex-officio member of each committee. The Woodbridge Education Association and the Beecher Road School PTO may each designate one individual per committee to represent their respective organizations at committee meetings. The Superintendent is a member of each committee and may appoint up to two additional administrators/ supervisors to serve on each committee. Policy decisions of the committees are non-binding; only the Woodbridge Board of Education may determine policy.
