BACKGROUND INFORMATION: House Bill 2, passed during the 89 th Texas Legislative session, significantly restricts a District of Innovation's ability to employ teachers of record who are in the process of completing requirements for obtaining educator certification credentials. As a result, Texas Education Code §21.0032 now limits the subject areas in which a teacher who is not yet fully certified can be employed. Districts may elect to delay full compliance with TEC §21.0032 until the 2029-2030 school year through the submission of an application and certification compliance plan. A delayed compliance date would enable teachers currently employed by the district to complete certification requirements.
