Education Act of 1965 (ESEA), as amended by the, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), which underscores the need for enhanced educational stability for students in foster care. Title I, Part A–Foster Care Program was established on December 10, 2016, under the, Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA). The purpose of this program is to ensure that children and youth in foster care have equal access to the same free, appropriate public education as provided to their peers living with biological parents or legal guardians. The Every Student Achieves Act provides all children and youth in foster care with core protections for school stability and school access through a statutory vehicle that is separate from the McKinney-Vento Act, and that outlines clear, distinct and appropriate responsibilities for both the education and child welfare agencies.
