When we moved to the area 10 years ago, my children were enrolled into your school district. This is where they made friends, joined the basketball team and educationally excelled. Marmaduke school is the only school they have ever known, it is where they feel at home. Last year we were informed that they would have to be enrolled in Paragould school district due to the fact that we had to relocate to Paragould due to severe mold in our home. 5 of the 10 years that we have lived in the state of Arkansas, we resided in Paragould and my children attended Marmaduke, even riding the bus from Paragould to Marmaduke and to the best of my knowledge I have never had to apply for school of choice. Since forcing my children into the Paragould school district their grades have dropped and their desire is gone. These are children and the system is failing them especially at Paragould school. My children have suffered depression from this and beg me to let them return to Marmaduke, so this is my plea to help put my kids back on the best path for them, with your school. I would also like to add that I am willing and able to provide all transportation for my children to and from your school. Dear Shawna Scoggin:

I am sorry, but the applications you submitted for Keagan Gamel, Kennedy Gamel, and Kamron Gamel have been rejected for the following reason.

Your child's resident district has declared itself exempt from the provisions of the School Choice Law due to it being under an enforceable desegregation order.

Your child's resident district has reached its limitation cap for allowable transfers and we cannot accept any additional school choice transfers from that district.

Your child does not meet the openings identified for the coming school-year identified in its Board of Directors Resolution adopted on July 14, 2014.
