# APPEAL

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to formally request an appeal on the decision made by the Midland School District (Resident District) to deny my school choice application I submitted on behalf of my child, Corey Vines.

The School Choice Application was submitted to the non-resident District, White County Central School on April 9, 2021. On May 11, 2021 the Midland School District emailed their letter of his eligibility (enclosed) to White County Central. May 24, 2021 my child was notified by his baseball coach that his request had been approved verbally. On May 27, 2021 I received a letter from the White County Central School District that my child had been accepted to their district for enrollment. To date, I have not received any written letter from the Midland School district that our School Choice Application has been denied furthermore, revoked. To my knowledge, this a direct violation of the law regarding the 10-day notice of their District to our family regarding their decision.

I would like to request an appeal of the Midland School District's rejection of our application based on the following reasons:

- 1. Test scores: White County School District reports higher test scores than that of the Midland School District. This would promote a higher level of learning and overall level of knowledge for my child. As an educator, I feel that this is an absolute need for an opportunity for my child to succeed not only in the classroom, but outside as well.
- 2. Transportation: I am employed in the Riverview School District in Searcy, Arkansas. I pass by the White County School District every day and would be able to drop my child off and pick him up. There are no other licensed drivers in our household. Previously, while attending Midland School District he had to depend on teammates and their parents for transportation after school if he had practice. This often meant he did not attend extracurricular activities because he was too embarrassed to ask. My campus is only 10 minutes from the White County School District so I can easily pick him up and it would

also allow me to attend more of these activities. I am over 30 minutes away from the Midland campus and that created a major problem for us.

- Friends: Corey's best friend will be attending White County School this year as well as several other good friends that he has played sports with over the years. This will allow more transportation options for him after school since these are families that we know well.
- 4. Work Schedule: as a coach, my schedule varies and my game nights can be long. I would feel more comfortable knowing that my child was closer to me and that I would have people that I know I can trust to help with his care. If there was an emergency for instance, I could be there much faster. My child has severe allergies as well as asthma and has needed urgent care in the past.

For all these reasons, I humbly ask that the decision of the Midland School District to deny the School Choice for my child be reversed and he would be allowed to attend the White County School District which is his school of choice for 2021-2022 school year.
