WHAT IS WIN TIME?

W.I.N. stands for What I Need



- Designated time within the master schedule
- Classroom instruction stops so that students can receive intervention and enrichment
- Every student. Every day.
- Specifically designed to meet the needs of each district, campus and student



WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE?

- One hour every day broken into 2-30 minute blocks
- Various instructional groups
 - Tier 3: RTI Classroom (4-5 students per group)
 - Tier 2: Classroom teacher (5-10 students per group)
 - Computer Lab (IXL)
 - GT/Enrichment (District-developed curriculum)
 - Resource (Math & Reading)
 - Dyslexia (Reading by Design)
