

Request for Approval of Additional Class Size Waivers (2019-2020 School Year)

Each school district in Texas is required to review its class size enrollment to determine whether its class sizes for grades K-4 exceed 22:1. If the review indicates that any class for grades K-4 exceeds the allowable class size limit of 22 students per class (22:1), the district must submit a request for exception under TEC §25.112(d).

Attached is a copy of the District's requests for a waiver from the class size maximum in grades K-4 for December and January of the 2019-20 school year. The dates used for the determination of the class size waivers were January 7, 2020 and February 1, 2020 respectively. This request is for 41 classrooms that were not on the original list that are now exceeding 22:1. 73 classrooms that were previously exceeding the 22:1 ratio are now at or below the allowable ratio.
