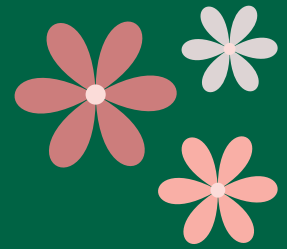


# MAY
