Annual Measurable Achievement Objective (AMAO) report has been published. It shows that Sheridan School District did not meet targets this year. As reported previously, the state is using a different growth model method for calculating the measure. This result indicates that students with lower English language proficiency are not making adequate progress when compared to peers.
