Kindergarten

In the 2nd 6 weeks we will be learning how to add and subtract numbers 1-10, compare numbers 1-10 and so much more! We will also be learning many more sight words and take books home that are on our level!! We will also be learning how to sound out CVC words and write them on our own and we are so excited to dig into non-fiction books and learn facts about animals.

First Grade

In ELAR we will be writing personal narratives. We will also learn to write about topics of interest, and we will learn about verbs and adjectives. In Math we will learn about place value and will continue to practice our addition and subtraction skills. In Social Studies, we will learn about our world; more specifically, landforms and America. Our Science lessons will focus on force and energy.

Second Grade

In Social Studies, we are learning about communities and will be taking a community field trip to explore our local treasures. We will visit the Heritage Museum, fire station, city library, county courthouse, and have lunch at the city park. This is a fun way for our students to appreciate our community. In Science, we are studying force, motion, and energy. In Math, we are learning about two, three, and four digit addition and subtraction with and without regrouping. In Reading, we are taking a look into expository texts and their features. In Writing, we are continuing to write drafts of topics of interest. We are also starting to learn how to revise and edit our writing.

Life Skills

In the Life Skills classes the students will dig into pumpkins! Students will do several activities with pumpkins including carving them and roasting the seeds. Life cycles will also be part of the October learning. Students will get to plant beans and watch them start to grow. The class is also looking forward to another fun WalMart trip for their materials!
