## School Board Goals

- 1. By June 30, 2016 School board members will take a more visible and active role in the community
  - Each school board member will visit all five programs (Early Childhood, Wildwood Elementary, OH Anderson Elementary, Middle School, and High School) at least one time during the school day
  - b. Each school board member will attend at least three district events (i.e. homecoming, performances, athletic events, etc.) involving students
  - c. School Board members will attend a staff listening session with Dr. Larson.
- 2. School Board members will continue professional development.
  - a. all members will participate in at least one SEED class/session in 2015-16
  - b. the majority of school board members will attend MSBA, NSBA, or some other professional training.
- 3. All School Board members will work outside the district to make positive change in the larger education arena
  - a. By June 30, 2016 at least ten individual contacts (may be some duplications) will be held with statewide or national legislators.
  - b. At least three board members will visit legislators to advocate for appropriate legislation to support Mahtomedi programs by June 30, 2016
  - c. at least three school board members will attend MSBA trainings, workshops or conferences
- 4. By June 30, 2016 the Board will convene "customer service" task force and report the findings back to the public.
  - a. board members will create a definition of "customer service"
  - b. needs assessment
  - c. protocols a fairly wide open definition
  - d. board members will identify metrics for determining strengths/weaknesses
  - e. board members with the superintendent will draft a plan for addressing concerns
