# **Plumbing**

Repair valve issue in toilet at Hornet Park.

# **HVAC**

Blower not engaging on HVAC in elementary comp lab. Replaced contact switch...unit is now working properly.

Purchased training materials for EPA license to purchase/handle freon and refrigerants. Once license is obtained we can then perform even more repairs on units which should further reduce our dependence on EFI. I should have the license by the end of March.

#### **Buses/Vehicles**

\*\*\*Prepared/submitted a grant application to receive 80% funding for the purchase of a new gasoline bus to replace Bus #1 in our fleet. If we win the grant (it is a competitive/first-come, first-served grant), we will have to destroy Bus #1 so that it cannot be used. The grant is sponsored by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) with the intent of reducing emissions created by old diesel buses. The deadline for submission is in October. I was able to submit the application just four days after the grant opportunity went public. I believe we have a good chance of winning the grant.

The past month I have spent several days putting together a grant application. I have also spent a great deal of time working on the Career and Technology Education (CTE) Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (CLNE) which must be submitted every two

years and is quite a detailed submission. I have also spent a substantial amount of time reviewing and updating training requirements for the asbestos and integrated pest management programs; not to mention, we have been away from school for 4 1/2 days due to weather.
