

Resolution of the Brackett Independent School District

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING JOINT ELECTIONS, AND MAY UNIFORM ELECTION DATE

WHEREAS, the Brackett Independent School District ("District") and Brackettville ("City") are each political subdivisions of the State of Texas;

WHEREAS, Section 11.0581 of the Texas Education Code requires that an election for school board trustees must be held on either the election date for the members of the governing body of a municipality located in the school district; or the general election date for state and county officers;

WHEREAS, elections held on the same date as provided by Texas Education Code Section 11.0581 shall be held as a joint election under Chapter 271, Texas Election Code;

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code § 271.002(a) authorizes the governing bodies of political subdivisions to enter into an agreement to hold joint elections that can be served by a common polling place;

WHEREAS, the City and the District serve electors within the same boundary, and it would be to the benefit of the City, the County, the District, and the citizens and voters thereof, to hold the elections jointly.

THEREFORE, the election for Brackett Independent School District Board of Trustees shall be held on the May uniform election date to comply with Texas Education Code Section 11.0581;

THEREFORE, the District shall participate in a joint election with the City of Brackettville on the terms and conditions as determined by the City and the District in a joint election agreement, in accordance with Texas Education Code §11.0581 and Texas Election Code Chapter 271.

THEREFORE, AND AS AMENDED, the District and the City agree to hold a joint election in May at a common polling place, as agreed upon and determined to be the Kinney County Civic Center, 200 E Spring Street, Brackettville, Texas;
