Professional Development

We met as a team and held one-on-one interviews with each Academy teacher. After reviewing the required reports, feedback was sought on the following:

- Professional needs
- Personal needs
- Suggestions
- Targeted feedback from the administration

Needs varied from instructional materials and classroom management needs to support from the administration. Along with the one-on-one interviews, the Academy teachers met in the following sub-committees with subsequent action items:

Attendance

- Monthly attendance recognition to include a dessert celebration along with verbal recognition via morning announcements.
- A student-of-the-month selection (character based) and placement on the cafeteria bulletin board. A teacher and administrator volunteered to establish and monitor the monthly selections and the yearbook class to assist with the bulletin board.

Student Growth

 This committee focused on better implementation of STAR data in advisory classes to include regular review of the data with the advisory teacher and the student, setting growth goals, and identifying/communicating specific focus areas.

Restorative Practices

 Professional development and instruction were identified for Emotional Intelligence and awareness to be provided on the next PD Day. A new teacher

- has had industry experience delivering this training and volunteered to share that as part of March professional development.
- Materials were identified for students who have been suspended for major discipline violations with the requirement for students to complete the training/meeting before reintegration into general education.

We had an incident in our Junior High with racial slurs and employed this model with good success. An online module was created, and upon completion, the students met with the administration to discuss the issue and redirect their behavior.
