Signs a Student May *Not* Be Ready to Learn

- Reverses letters or skips words
- Struggles with phonics
- Poor listening/comprehension
- Trouble writing, cutting, or coloring
- Difficulty following directions
- Constant movement or falls out of chair

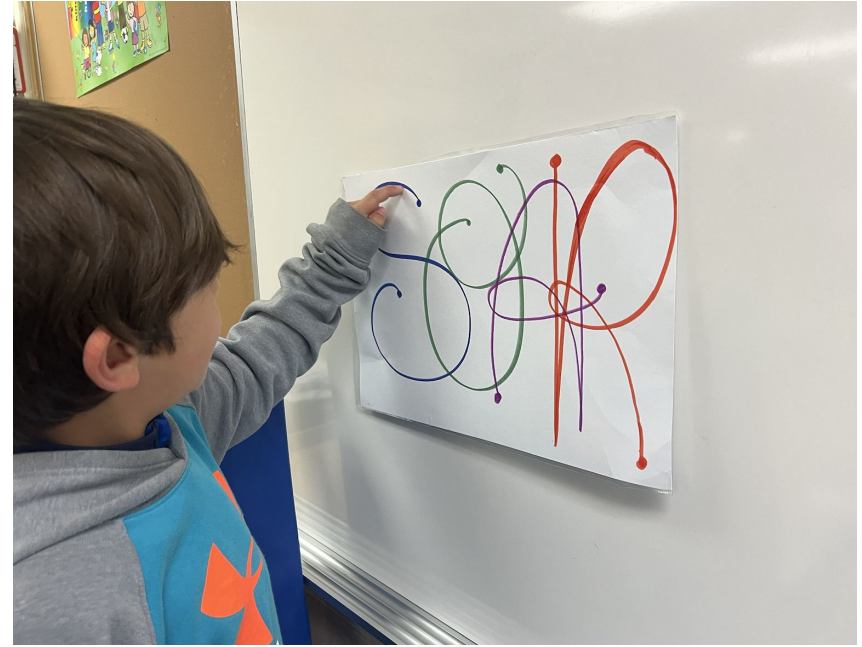
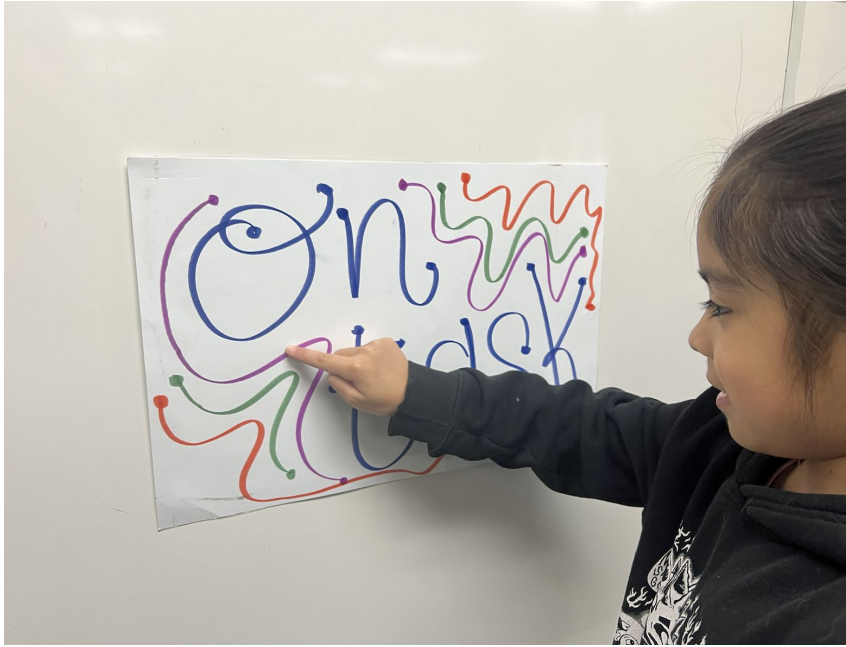
These behaviors = clues the **brain-body system needs more support.**

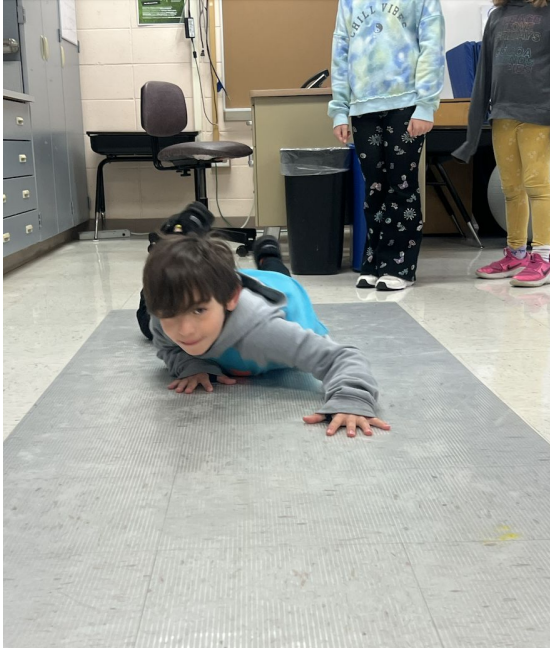

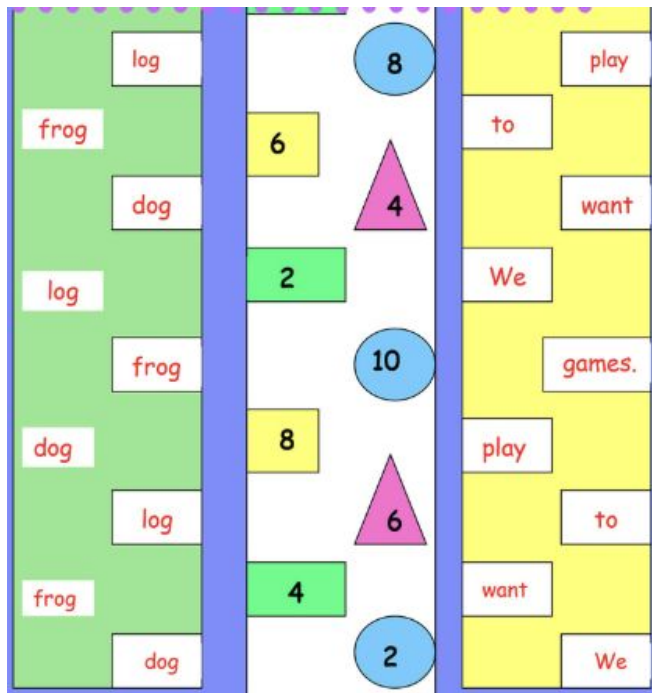
Alligator Crawl

Creep Tracks

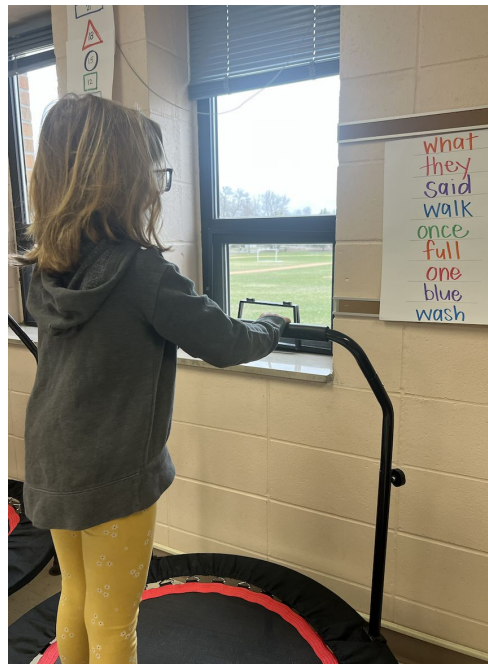
