March's Characteristic is Integrity

Each month, GGS focuses on a personal characteristic and teaches it to our students.

Our focus for the month of March is Integrity. Demonstrating integrity is doing the right thing when no one else is looking. Ensuring you are acting with integrity is being honest and leading with your moral compass and helping others out.

At the end of the month we will be handing out three awards in each class, two for students who were demonstrating integrity, and one Pride of the Pack award focused on perseverance. Please talk with your child(ren) around the conversations and acts of integrity they are practicing at school.

Counselor's Corner - Ms. H

We now have all the tools in our toolbox! This past month we talked about kindness and how using our apology and forgiveness tool is a kind act. Mistakes happen as we are learning, and we fix those hurts with our apology and forgiveness tool. The glue represents this tool because we are gluing back together what was broken.

Our final tool is our quiet safe place tool. The headphones are used to represent this tool. In my class lessons we practiced going to our quiet safe place in our minds. We talked about how it is our mini vacation tool and that our bodies can't always go there, but our minds can. We had fun leaving the classroom without really leaving.

During March we will be working on our empathy, courage, and words tool as we begin to learn about treating everyone with respect during our bully prevention lessons.

Each tool includes a small icon: a tape measure for Breathing, headphones for Quiet/Safe Place, a hand holding a pencil for Listening, a ruler for Empathy, a ball of string for Personal Space, a pencil for Using Our Words, a trash can for Garbage Can, a watch for Taking Time, a key for Please & Thank You, a bottle of glue for Apology & Forgiveness, a piece of paper for Patience, and a pair of scissors for Courage.

Rockaway Beach, January 28, 2022 – The Neah-Kah-Nie School District, based on the Every Student Belongs guidance from the Oregon Department of Education, adopted its new equity statement in May 2021 and finalized its equity lens in October 2021.
