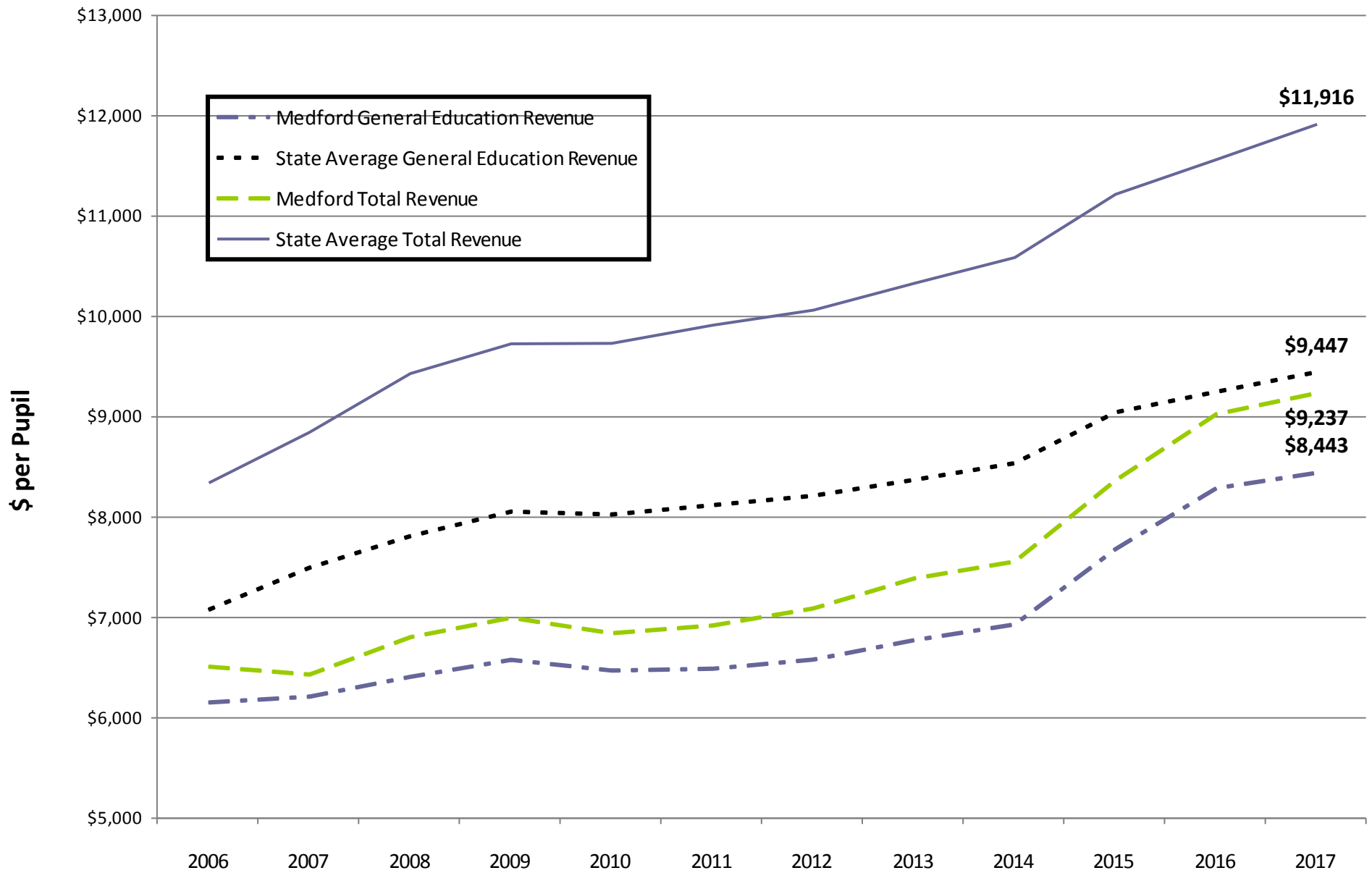


# Medford Revenue Compared to the State Average
