## DATE OF MEETING: October 4, 2016

## TITLE: Approval of New School Name

### **BACKGROUND:**

This item is presented to the Governing Board in preparation for the naming of the new Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) elementary school.

Governing Board Policy FF (Naming Facilities) sets forth that:

"Due to the fact that there are many worthy individuals and requests from various sources requesting that various schools be named after said individuals and the District's inability to honor all of these requests, it is the desire of the Governing Board that naming of schools after individuals be discouraged. Responsibility for making nominations of names for schools to the Governing Board will reside in a joint committee of the Governing Board, the professional staff, the students, and community representatives."

A committee consisting of nine members and a facilitator was formed with the purpose of narrowing the names suggested by the public to between three and five names for possible consideration by the Governing Board. School names were submitted in a suggestion box, through social media channels, and through a link on our district web site from September 1st to September 23rd. There were approximately 180 submissions, some were duplicates. The committee met twice to review all of the submissions and narrow the list.
