Principal's Report to SAC

- 1. Current student enrollment: 85 students
- 2. Staffing:
 - a. Currently have a full teaching staff with five long-term subs.
 - b. Still Vacant: Cook's Helper and paraprofessional positions
- 3. Winter MAP and WIDA testing have been completed. Grades 3-8 have all shown positive growth in reading, which is a focus area this year.
- 4. Staff have completed district training for state testing, and site training has been scheduled for March 15th.
- 5. Site inservice March 11th will be used to provide further professional development in the areas of crisis prevention and fetal alcohol syndrome disorders.
- 6. Ongoing professional development in restorative practices has been scheduled throughout second semester.
- 7. Weekly positive behavior incentives have been successful and will continue throughout second semester.
- 8. Basketball teams are traveling to Regionals Wednesday, March 1st. We have three additional students attending Prom.
- 9. Emergency Response Coordinator Jimmy Capps was on site with a team from ICAS and FEMA. The group collaborated with the school and community leaders to develop an emergency response and evacuation plan. The team also shared information about the WEBEOC early warning system and started signing community members up for the system. The team will continue to collaborate with the school and community to further develop and implement the plans which have been started.
- 10. At the SAC's request, pre-school hours will be extended for the 2023-2024 school year. This aligns with the district's goal of increasing literacy and Inupiaq language proficiency.
- 11. CTE Director Ronnie Hawley was on site for three days working with our CTE teacher to help re-establish the shop program. This semester we have five shop classes for secondary students.
