### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The district instructional data dashboard provides the district with a systematic process for gathering multiple data points to track implementation levels of the district instructional focus areas and to monitor student progress data throughout the school year.

- During the 2024-2025 school year, the Math Department has focused on bridging achievement gaps in mathematics, enhancing student engagement, and increasing postsecondary readiness as follows:
  - Curriculum Writing: Ensures that math instruction is cohesive, standards-aligned, and intentionally designed.
  - Vertical and Horizontal Alignment: Aligning curriculum coherence across grade levels to ensure seamless progression and consistency within each level.
  - Learner Engagement: Implementing instructional strategies aimed at igniting curiosity and active participation.
  - Postsecondary Readiness in Math: Analyzing student data, providing targeted math intervention and increasing college readiness initiatives.
