**Executive Summary:**

- Administration is recommending a small meal price increase for the elementary campuses, the last price increase was the 2023-24 school year.
- Material increases are recommended for the High School in order to purchase alternative meal choices since opting out of the National School Lunch Program.
- For the High School the District will cover students who would normally qualify for free and reduced lunches.
- A la carte pricing is included for reference only and is not subject to board approval.

Adjustments to La Vernia High School meal prices are necessary to address rising operational costs and the school's non-participation in the National School Lunch Program this year.

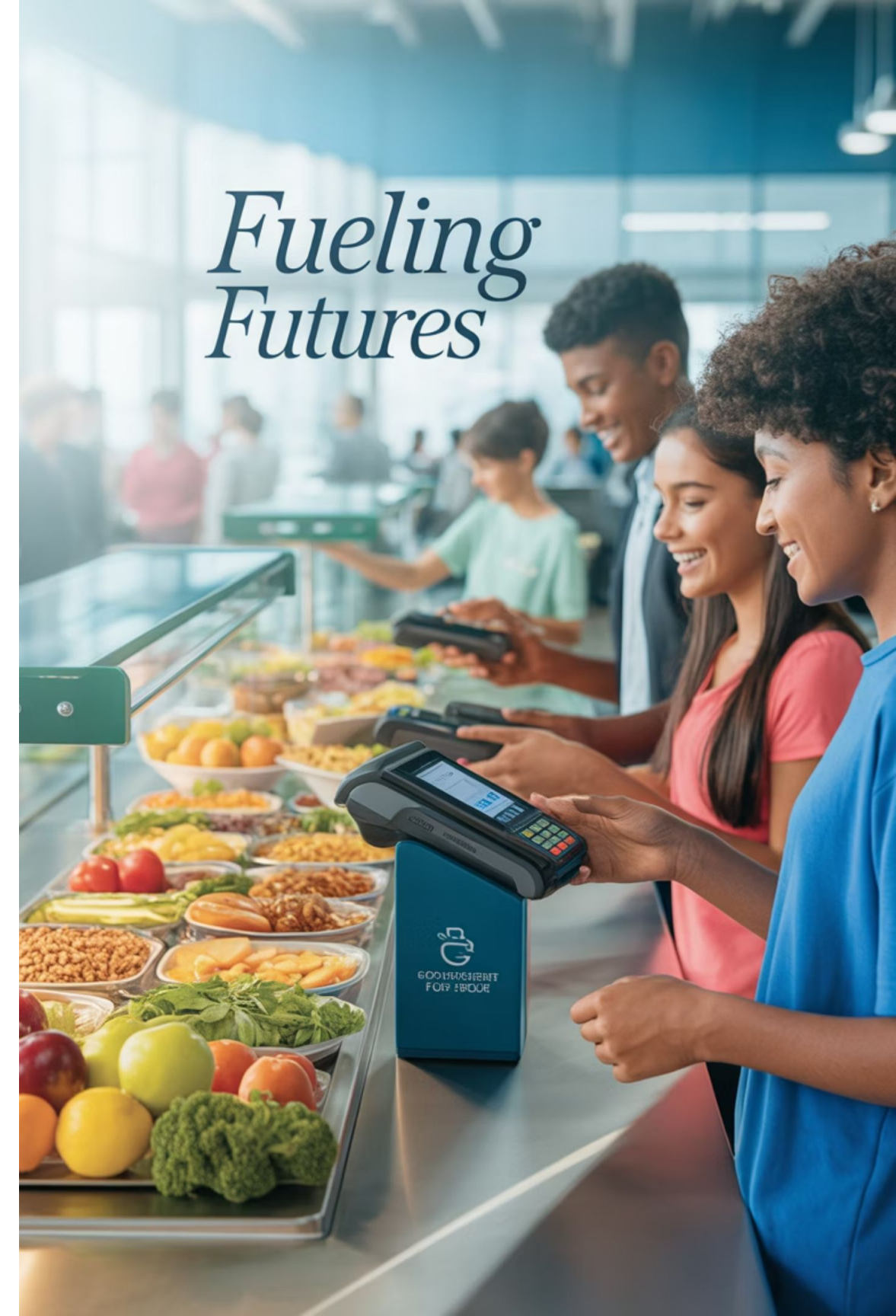
Breakfast: \$2.50 (+\$0.75) | **Lunch:** \$4.50 (+\$1.55)
