Executive Summary:

- Administration is recommending a small meal price increase for the elementary campuses, the last price increase was the 2023-24 school year.
- Material increases are recommended for the High School in order to purchase alternative meal choices since \bullet opting out of the National School Lunch Program.
- For the High School the District will cover students who would normally qualify for free and reduced lunches. \bullet
- A la carte pricing is included for reference only and is not subject to board approval.





Proposed High School Prices 2025-2026

Adjustments to La Vernia High School meal prices are necessary to address rising operational costs and the school's non-participation in the National School Lunch Program this year.
