TOPIC: Approval of Bid Results for Athletic Field Projects - Sinking Fund

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District, approve the recommendation from the Owner's Representative, Plante Moran CRESA, to approve athletic field improvements for Churchill High School and turf replacement at Churchill, Franklin, and Stevenson High Schools in the amount of \$2,945,122.68, plus contingency in the amount of \$131,581.00, for a total of \$3,076,703.68, and authorize the Superintendent or her designee to negotiate and execute final contracts on behalf of the Board of Education with the recommended contractors.

RATIONALE:

This Sinking Fund project will provide athletic field improvements at Churchill High School in the summer of 2018. Additionally, field turf pricing will be locked in for similar projects at Franklin and Stevenson High School in the summer of 2019.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

The source of funds for these purchases will be the Sinking Fund.
