Custodians are working hard on summer projects and getting the rooms and school

ready for next year. Thank you to Von, Cathy, and Cheryl for working hard. Thanks to Steve for keeping up with the landscaping and odd jobs on rainy days. It really does take a team to get the school ready for the next school year!

Northome Principal's Report: This is our last week of Summer School for grades K-6. Students had the opportunity to participate in a variety of different activities in and outside of the classroom. Robotics certainly seemed to be the most popular. I want to thank all of the staff that helped out to provide these learning opportunities for our students. We still have one more week of Credit Recovery in August. Our Trap Team went to the state shoot in Alexandria in June. The Food Pantry has been a busy place the last few weeks. We are excited to have families coming in on a regular basis. We continue to partner with Second Harvest Food Shelf to support our families and community. The custodial staff has been busy cleaning, painting and repairing. We are incredibly thankful for all of the work they put in to keep our school in great shape.

Board Report: The board is trying to finalize topics for classified contract negotiations.

Superintendent's Report: This week Nelson's roofing began work on the Indus school. Project should take about a month and once completed they will move onto Northome. The gymnasium floor at Indus was sanded and resealed last week. They have moved to Northome this week and hope to have both gymnasiums completed by Friday. Notice of filing dates for School Board Elections have been posted. Interested Board candidates can file at either the Indus or Northome campuses. The filing period runs from August 2nd through August 16th. We have three current licensed openings within our district. Open FACS and PE/Health in Indus and an Open ADSIS position in Northome. Northome Community Ed - T-Ball wrapped up the last week of June. 8U, 10U and 12U baseball and 12U will wrap up in mid-late July.
