**RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A STATE OF MICHIGAN GRANT FOR
PART 115 MATERIALS MANAGEMENT PLAN**

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 26-354
ADOPTED January 20, 2026**

WHEREAS the State of Michigan enacted amendments to Part 115, Solid Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act (NREPA), 1994 PA 451, as amended, requiring counties to develop and implement a Materials Management Plan MCL 324.11571); and

WHEREAS the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) has made grant funding available to assist counties with the development, update, and implementation of Part 115 Materials Management Plan; and

WHEREAS Gratiot County has applied for and has been awarded a grant from the State of Michigan for the purpose of supporting activities related to the Part 115 Materials Management Plan; and

WHEREAS acceptance of this grant will provide financial assistance to the County to ensure compliance with state law and to support responsible materials management, recycling, and waste reduction efforts; and

WHEREAS the grant does not require the expenditure of County general funds beyond those identified and approved within the grant agreement, if any.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Gratiot County Board of Commissioners hereby accepts the State of Michigan grant for the Part 115 Materials Management Plan in the amount of \$90,800.50 subject to the terms and conditions of the attached grant agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairperson of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign any documents consistent with this resolution, subject to approval as to form by the County Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate County departments are authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to implement the grant-funded activities in accordance with applicable state requirements.
