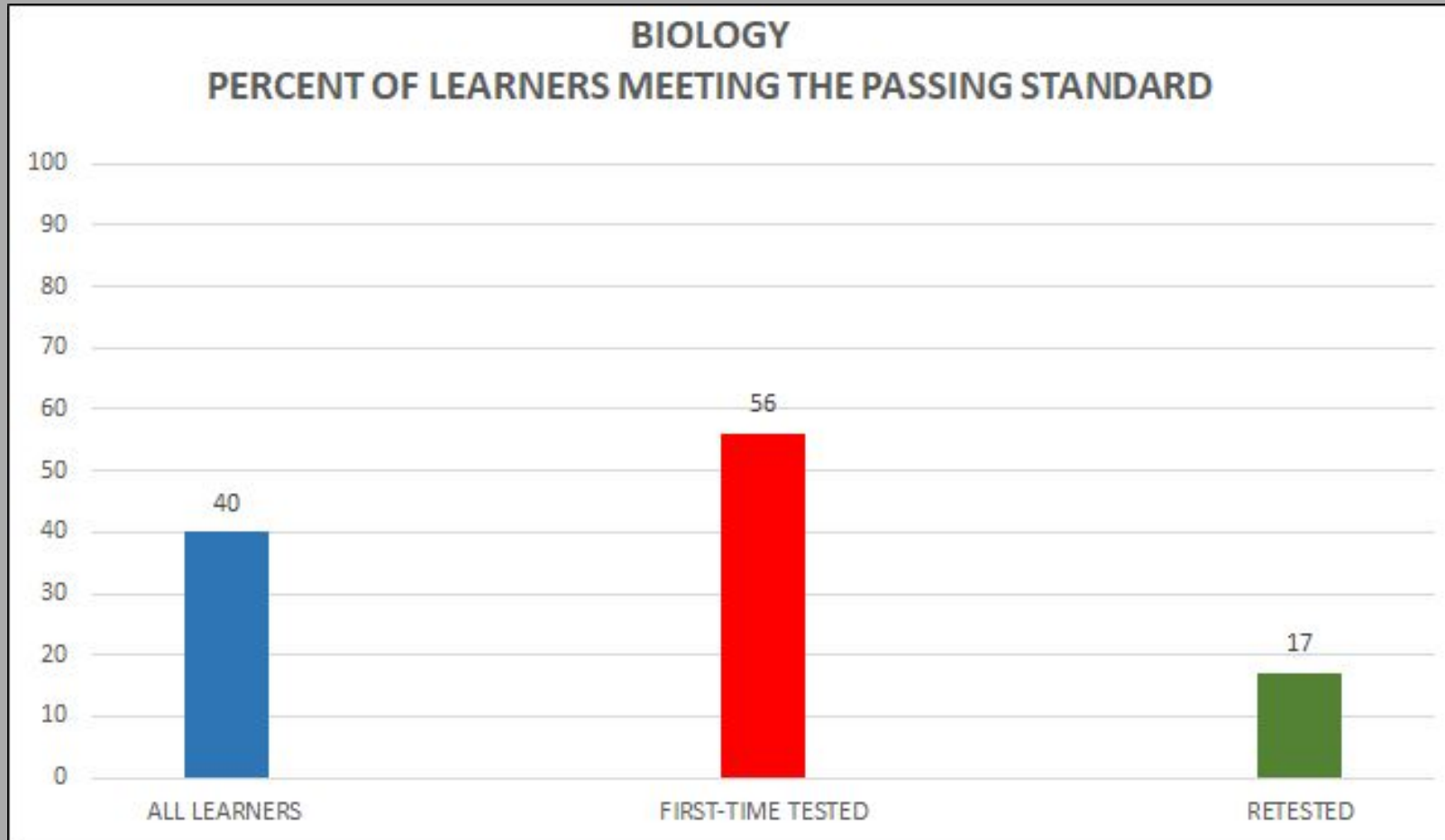

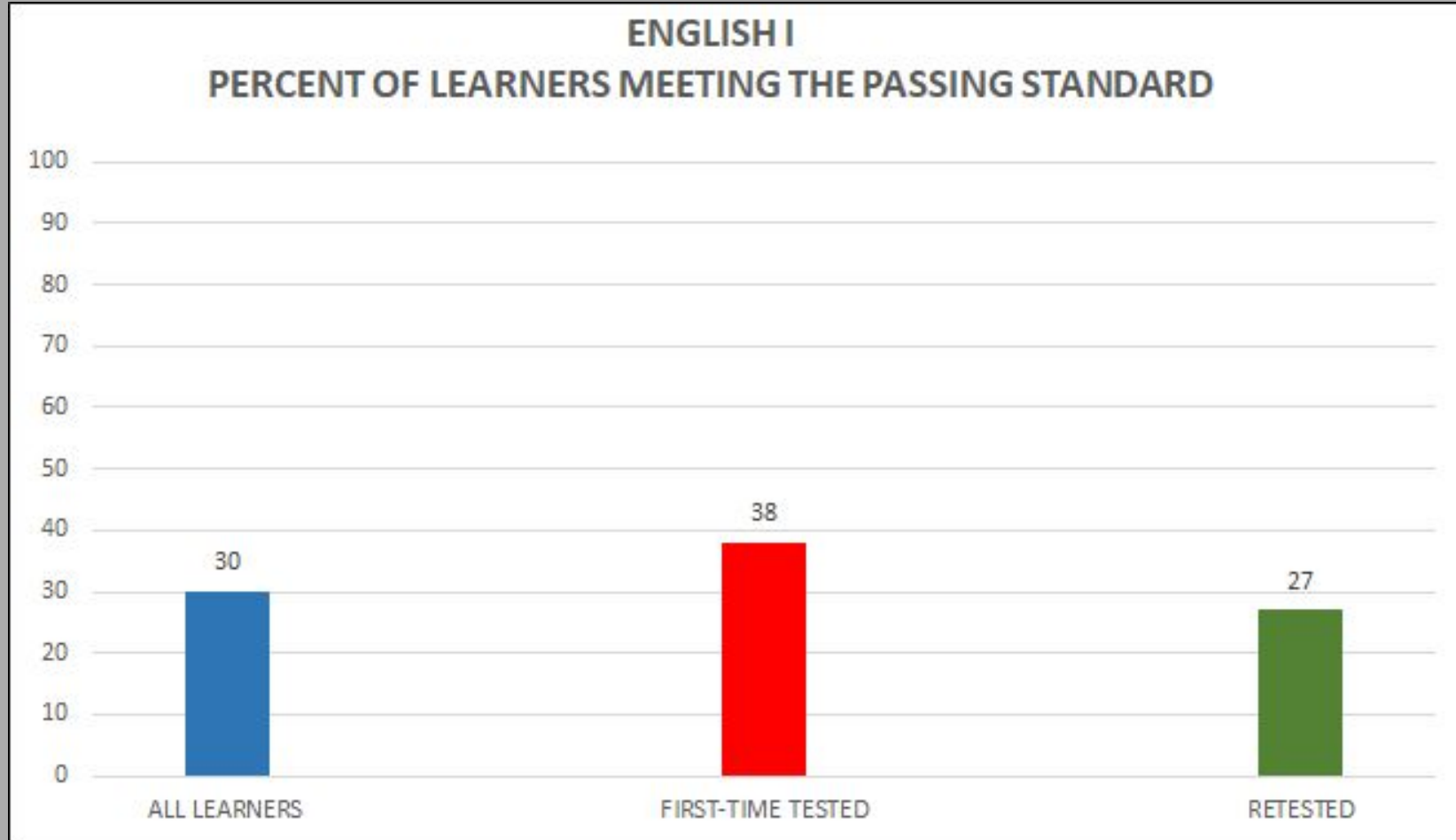

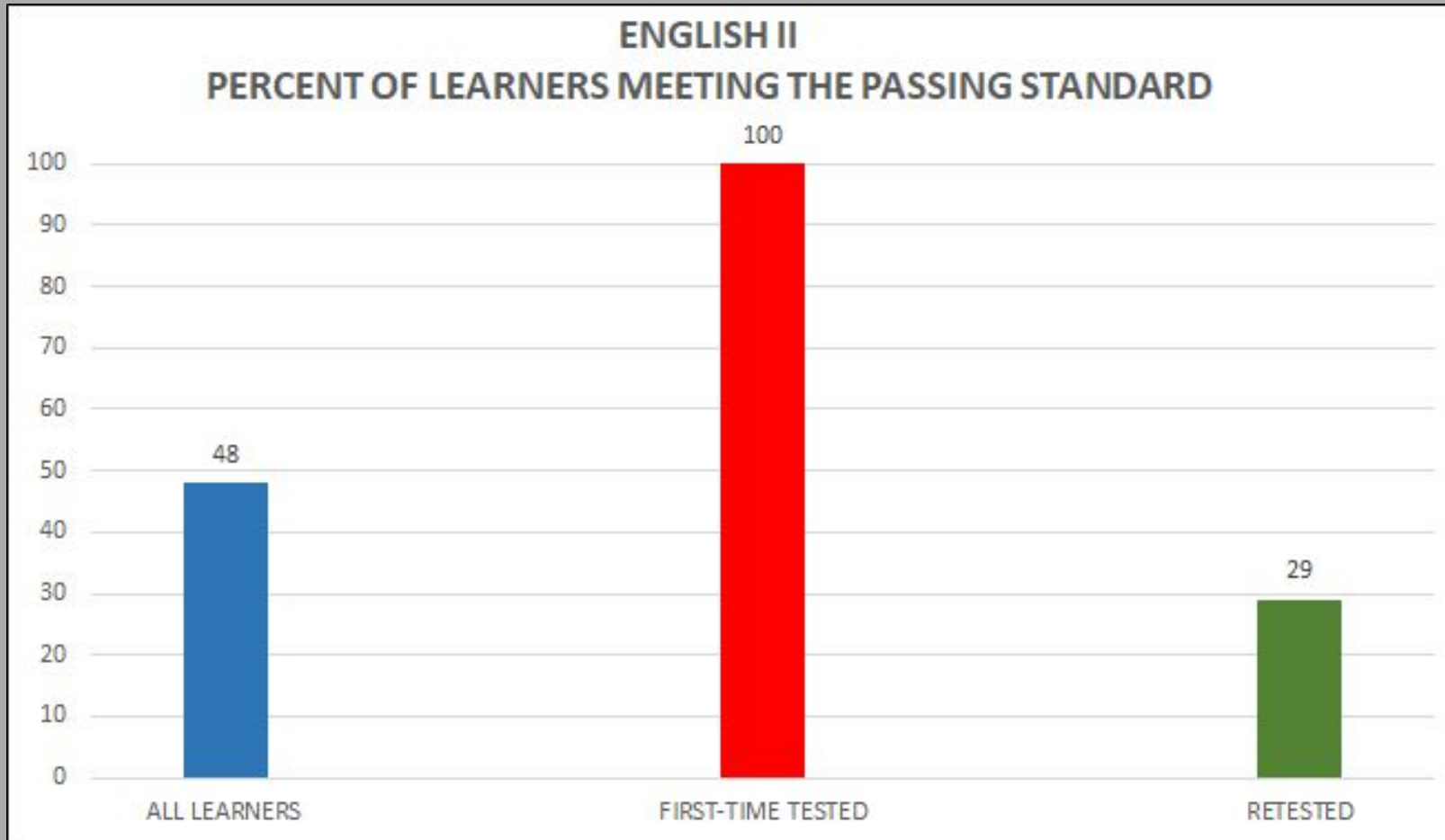

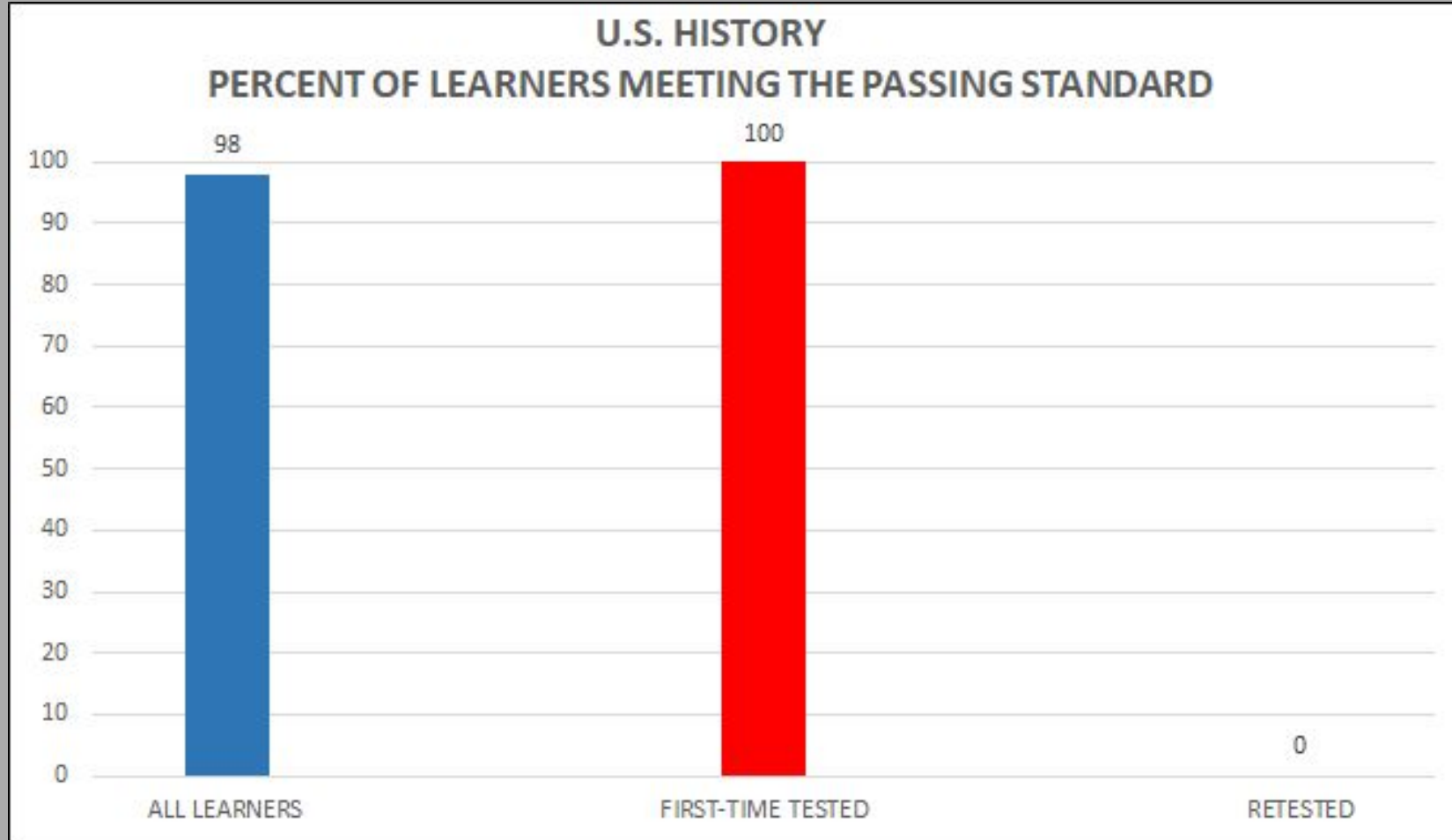

RECOGNITIONS

- ❑ The number of EOCs remaining to be taken by retesters has decreased by 40%. The number of learners who have one EOC to retest for has decreased by 55%.
- ❑ The number of learners who have retested on EOCs has decreased for every assessment with English II decreasing the most..
- ❑ The percentage of retesters who met the passing standards for Algebra I and English II increased from 2019 to 2020.
- ❑ The percentage of retesters meeting the passing standard on the Algebra I EOC increased by 10%.



AREAS FOR GROWTH

- ❑ The percentage of first-time testers who met the passing standard on the Algebra I EOC dropped from 100% to 43% from 2019 to 2020.
- ❑ The percentage of first-time testers who met the passing standard on the English I EOC dropped from 50% to 38% from 2019 to 2020.
- ❑ The percentage of retesters who met the passing standard on the Biology EOC dropped 10% from 2019 to 2020.
