Together, we have worked to create a push-in model of support that we feel will greatly benefit our most vulnerable, at-risk students.

©Curriculum improvements: Our curriculum and instruction team has worked tirelessly to prepare for our new courses and we are extremely excited to continue the process of working together to create courses that will challenge our students' thinking and foster academic achievement for all. We believe our courses will be rigorous but fully accessible for students so that every student can successfully master their grade level TEKS.
