When a Closed Session is placed on the agenda as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Section 551.001 et seq., topics for discussion must concern any and all purposes permitted by the Act, including, but not limited to the following sections:

- (b) at a subsequent public meeting of the Board of Trustees upon notice thereof as the Board shall determine.
