Backpack Program/Homeless/At-Risk

Counselors

- October is Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness month. Campuses are planning education opportunities for students and sending information out to parents. The district also sent a newsletter aimed at providing education to parents. Fentanyl poisoning is the #1 cause of death in young adults aged 18-24.
