TITLE: **Recognition of Ironwood Ridge High School Students' LNA Certification**

BACKGROUND:

Four students in the Ironwood Nursing Program have earned their Licensed Nursing Assistant (LNA) certification. This year was the first full-year of the nursing program, which is a partnership with Pima Community College and is the only program of its kind in Pima County.

Students who earn their LNA are prepared to enter the medical field immediately or continue to a state university to complete a bachelor of science degree in about two years or a master of science degree in four years.

To earn the certification, students completed more than 280 hours of instruction, skill-building and clinical practice and passed testing requirements.


