ALIGNS TO BOARD GOAL(S): LEARNING: The District will provide an aligned, rigorous curriculum, with instructional and technology programs preparing students to meet or exceed all educational standards.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Texas Education Agency has released accountability ratings for the 2017-2018 school year. To be rated as “Met Standard,” the District and each campus must meet all applicable domain indicators. If any one or more of the domain indicators is missed, the rating is “Improvement Required.” Meeting Standard in 2018 combines the three domains to achieve the overall rating. Better of Achievement or Progress accounts for 70%, and 30% from Closing the Gaps.

Domain III: CLOSING THE GAPS

Aledo ISD and each campus were rated “Met standard” by the State.

DISTINCTION DESIGNATIONS

Each campus is evaluated compared to its campus comparison group of 40 most similar schools to determine campus distinction designations. Aledo ISD campuses received the following distinctions for the 2017-18 school year:
